EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004-1

CREATING TASK FORCE DISIPLINA AND ITS COMPONENT TEAMS TO ENFORCE SPECIFICLAWS AND ORDINANCES, DEFINING THEIR AND COMPOSITION

WHEREAS, there are existing laws, ordinances, rules and regulations which are not properly enforced in the City of Naga;

WHEREAS, such manner of enforcement defeats the intent of such laws, ordinances rules and regulations, compromises the general welfare and erodes faith in government;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, Jesse M. Robredo, city mayor, do hereby create Task Force Disiplina with the following composition and functions:

Sec 1. TEAMS. The following teams are herein created to enforce specific laws and ordinances with the following functions and compositions:

Team A:

Objective **Clear** waiting sheds and trimobile stations and their immediate

periphery of vending activities.

Team B:

Objective **Clear** streets of illegal/unauthorized vendors

Responsibility entity: Market office

Support entities Naga City PNP as may be needed by market office

Responsible person Mr. Paco Ojeda

Immediate task Check with mayor and SP legal/authorized areas for vending,

with MetroPESO of any livelihood commitments by the city

Team C:

Objective **Clear** public of illegal structures prioritized in accordance with

their adverse effect on cleanliness and order.

Responsibility entity: City Engineer's Office Responsible person : Engr. Leon Palmiano IV

Immediate tasks : Prepare a list of such illegal structures copy furnished the CMO

not later than one week from this order

Team D:

Objective : Clear streets of junk/abandoned vehicles and equipment

Responsibility entity: Motorpool Responsibility person: Engr. Joel Martin

Immediate task : Inventory list of junk/abandoned vehicles and equipment and

inform owners of those within immediate vicinity if owners

cannot be located

Team E:

Objective : Clear urban district of illegal parking including those by civil

servants and police or other uniformed personnel

Ensure that padyaks have red reflectorized sticker at the rear and a yellow reflectorized sticker at the front, and that all rear

lights of trimobiles are operational

Enforce jaywalking and enforce anti littering laws

Responsibility entity: Transport and Traffic management office

Responisbility person: Councilor William Kalaw

Objective : **Control** throwing of garbage and release of domestic waste

into the Naga River, make it costly for those who insist

Control littering within urban district

Objective : **Ensure** safe and sanitary boarding houses

Responsibility person: Dr. Vito Borja for sanitation, Engr. Palmiano for Building, Fire

Chief for fire safety

Immediate task : Start joint inspection of all boarding houses within one week

Hold an orientation not later than the end of June.

Support function : Render legal advise on the power enforcement of laws and

ordinances and assists during the orientation on laws and

ordinances

Institute legal action against recalcitrant violators of laws and

ordinances

Responsibility entity : City Legal Office Responsible person : Atty. Nelson Legacion

Immediate tasks : Prepare a list of national laws or cleanliness and order which

can be enforced by local authorities copy furnished the CMO

within one week from this Order.

Assist the sangguniang panglungsod secretariat during the

Orientation

Support function : **Mobilize** other offices and departments as may be necessary to

assist Task Force Disiplina in the performance of its functions

specifying the tasks and timetable for such offices and

departments

Responsibility entity : City Mayor's Office Responsible person : Frank Mendoza

Sec. 3. **Task Force Disiplina.** All responsible persons referred to above are herein constituted into **Task Force Disiplina.** All responsible shall maintain and open line of communication among themselves to facilitate coordination. Any need for assistance from other offices not represented herein shall be coursed thru the Chief of Staff simply by phone, cell or text for expediency. The COS shall serve as facilitator for the various teams, convene its meetings, and render a regular progress report to the city mayor.

Sec. 4. **Implementation schedule.** The implementation schedule of all teams should be prepared immediately upon receipt of this Order and submitted during the first meeting of the Task Force which shall not be later than June 16, 2004.
