REORGANIZING THE NAGA CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 309 OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES, AS AMENDED:

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 309 issued by the President of the Philippines on November 11, 1987, as amended by Executive Order No. 317, mandating the reorganization of the Peace & Order Council in the national, regional, provincial, city and municipal levels of government has been the basis for the creation, reconstitution and continuing existence of the Naga City Peace & Order Council;

WHEREAS, said executive order provides that it is the duty of local governments, the law enforcement agencies, the prosecution services and similar institutions of government to assist the Executive in the proper enforcement of the laws and the administration of justice;

WHEREAS, in order to suppress criminality and maintain peace and order in the city, there is a need for fully coordinated measures that involves that the government officials and the citizenry;

WHEREAS, with the assumption of the new set of City Officials - elected - during the May 10, 2004, under a new Administration, there is a need to reorganize the Naga City Peace and Order Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JESSE M. ROBREDO, -City Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the Naga City Peace & Order Council under the new Administration, to wit:

The composition of the Naga City Peace and Order Council shall be by office or sector represented by its incumbent official/representative.

The Council shall meet every last Tuesday of the month at 3:00 p.m. at the Sanggunian Session Hall at City Hall or on a date and time as maybe determined by the members.

If for any unavoidable circumstances a POC Council member cannot attend a meeting, he can send an official representative who can speak for his office or sector.

The Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as has always been, shall be the Secretary of the Council to be assisted by a Secretariat composed of Sanggunian personnel who have been designated since.

This Executive Order supersedes all previous Executive Orders issued to this effect, and same shall take effect immediately with copies furnished all members for their information and guidance.
