EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2006-03

ESTABLISHING A “KAAGAPAY SA HANAPBUHAY ANG MGA BARANGAY” PROGRAM

WHEREAS, there are priority infrastructure projects that have been identified in the Barangay Development Plans of the 27 barangays of the city that have not been implemented due to budgetary limitations;

WHEREAS, to hasten the implementation of these infrastructure projects and to complement the limited barangay funds, the assistance of the city is needed in the realization of these barangays Development Plans;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to develop the capacity of the barangays to implement infrastructure projects with the assistance of the city government;

WHEREAS, for this purpose, a program specifically addressing these concerns must be established subject to certain conditions to maximize its benefits;

NOW THEREFORE, I JESSE M. ROBREDO, City Mayor of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. – Title. – This Executive Order shall be known as the “Kaagapay sa Hanapbuhay and mga Barangay” Program.

SECTION 2. – Coverage. – The program shall cover infrastructure projects as identified and prioritized by the 27 Barangay Councils. The implementation of such projects shall be done through the respective Barangay Councils provided that at least 5% of the total cost will be appropriated from the barangay fund as equity and the remaining 95% will be charged to the City Government of Naga subject to the approval of the City Mayor.

SECTION 3. – Objectives. – Infrastructure projects under this program shall:

- a. use labor-based tools-supported method;
- b. generate employment among the barangay residents;
- c. train the unskilled laborers for greater employability;
- d. develop a sense of responsibility among residents; and
- e. pump-prime the barangay economy.

SECTION 4. – Workforce. – In hiring the laborers, the following shall be observed:

- a. 100% of the unskilled workers shall come from within the concerned barangay;
- b. 50% of the skilled workers shall come from within the concerned barangay;
- c. The workers belong to the marginalized sector such as but not limited to the unemployed, underemployed, out-of-school youth, off-peak agricultural workers, displaced workers, informal settlers, urban poor;

SECTION 5. – Coordinating Committee. – For effective implementation, a Coordinating Committee is hereby created to be composed by the City Planning and Development Coordinator as chair, the City PESO Manager as Secretariat, the City Engineer for the preparation of plans and cost estimates, and the General Services Officer for Bidding purposes. Subject to the approval of the City Mayor and in order to standardized implementation of this program, the committee may, from time to time, issue guidelines to, among others, detail the operating procedures, clarify complementation and accountabilities and personnel involved, fix the timetable for the performance of their functions, and standardized the forms, documents and processes involved.

SECTION 6. – Repealing Clause. – Executive orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances of the city government, inconsistent with this are hereby modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. – Effectivity. – This executive order shall take effect upon its approval.
