

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2010-011

RECONSTITUTING THE PROJECT MONITORING COMMITTEE

Whereas, Executive Order no. 93 mandates the creation of Project Monitoring Committees (PMC) in all local government units in the country;

Whereas, the PMC, a multi-sectoral body composed of city government personnel and private sector representatives, ensures that infrastructure projects are implemented in accordance with the standards and specifications of the city government.

Whereas, the PMC checks infrastructure projects during implementation and conducts final inspection prior to the processing of the contractor's vouchers and sanctions errant contractors ranging from diminution of payment, reworking of defective portions, to outright blacklisting and withholding of payment.

Whereas, there is a need to reconstitute the Project Monitoring Committee relative to the fresh mandate of new administration.
