

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2011-025

**CREATING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE  
I.O.M.-SUPPORTED MAINSTREAMING MIGRATION IN LOCAL  
DEVELOPMENT PLANS PROJECT (MMLDPP) IN NAGA CITY  
AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:-**

**WHEREAS**, the International Organization for Migration (IOM) is the leading inter-governmental organization in the field of migration that works closely with governmental, intergovernmental and non-governmental partners;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine office of IOM has received a small funding grant from its Geneva headquarters to implement a migration and development project in partnership with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) entitled “Mainstreaming Migration in Local Development Plans: A Pilot Project for the Philippines”;

**WHEREAS**, the project hopes to contribute to the Philippine Government’s efforts to improve migration management in the country, in accordance with the recently-adopted European Union (EU)-Government of the Republic of the Philippines (GRP) Multi-Annual Indicative Programme (MIP);

**WHEREAS**, during discussions with the DILG, it was agreed that Naga City is the best pilot LGU for this initiative, mainly because the project will benefit from the sound local development planning system of the City Government;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to create a Technical Working Group that will ensure the effective and efficient implementation of this IOM-supported project by ensuring proper coordination among stakeholders and the over-all success of its component activities.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, John G. Bongat, City Mayor of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**Section 1.** The Naga City Mainstreaming Migration in Local Development Plans (MMLDP) Technical Working Group (TWG) is hereby created with the following composition:

**Section 2.** The TWG shall assume responsibility over the attainment of the following targets under the MMLDP:

- a) To pilot the mainstreaming of migration in local development planning;
- b) To develop training materials and/or toolkit; and
- c) To present the experience of the Naga City Government to a larger national stakeholder.

Toward this end, it will coordinate with all local and national government agencies, as well as other stakeholders in society, in mobilizing the support and resources required for the attainment of the abovementioned objectives.

**Section 3.** The TWG will report directly to the City Mayor, who will exercise control and supervision over its operations.

**Section 4.** This Executive Order shall be effective immediately.
