

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2012-010

ESTABLISHING A REINFORCED ANTI-FENCING PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF NAGA TO BE KNOWN AS THE A.P.R.U.B PROGRAM BY INVOLVING VARIOUS SECTORS OF SOCIETY:-

WHEREAS, reports from law enforcement agencies reveal that the most prevalent index crime in Naga are crimes against properties;

WHEREAS, such crimes continue to thrive due to existence of ready buyers commonly known as fence, of stolen properties;

WHEREAS, in order to combat the increase in number of crimes against property, and in this instance, fencing, there is an imperative need to institute a comprehensive anti-fencing program that will involve the various sectors of society;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, JOHN G. BONGAT AND HER LYNN F. BALARES, Mayor and City Youth Mayor of the City of Naga, respectively, and by virtue of the powers vested in us by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. The A.P.R.U.B. Program – The APRUB Program stands for the Bikol words: ARATUBANGON, PANIRIMBANGON, RALAMAGON, URUNTUKON, BARAGUHON, that will be used as strategies to curb crimes against property in the city.

As an approach against fencing and other forms of crimes against property of similar nature, the team that is hereinafter established shall:

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| A | ARATUBANGON | Initiate meetings and dialogues with suspected fence, and individuals suspected of being involved in robberies or thieveries for the purpose of making them aware that they are being monitored by authorities; |
| P | PANIRIMBANGON | Make perpetrators accountable through whatever lawful means in order to give justice to victims of crimes committed; |
| R | RALAMAGON | Go after those who have committed crimes against property by prosecuting and bringing them to the courts of justice; |

- U URUNTUKON Put a stop to these nefarious criminal activities and implement efforts to counter would-be perpetrators from committing these wrongdoings through profiling.
- B BARAGUHON Make efforts to reform those who have transgressed the laws.

Section 2. The Team. A team to ensure the proper coordination and implementation of the program herein established is hereby being constituted, *viz*,

Chairman	:	City Mayor
Vice Chairman	:	SP Committee Chairman on Peace and Order
Members	:	City Director of the Naga City Police Office City Legal Officer City Social Welfare and Development Officer City Treasurer Liga ng mga Barangay President Kapisanan ng mga Brodkaster ng Pilipinas Chairperson Public Safety Officer

Section 3. In order to make the implementation of this program more effective, the team shall regularly meet with operators of jewelry shops, junkshops, pawnshops, *kalakal, pararelo* (watch repairmen/shops), and other shops or establishments buying and selling second-hand goods and merchandise.

Section 4. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
