EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2013- 018

**RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY PROJECT MONITORING  
COMMITTEE (PMC) AND ITS SECRETARIAT**

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT**, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reconstitute the Naga City Project Monitoring Committee in accordance with Executive Order No. 376, series of 1989, as amended by Executive Order No. 93, dated June 1, 1993, as follows:

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** The Project Monitoring Committee shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 3. SCOPE OF MONITORING.** The scope of monitoring shall include all foreign and nationally-funded projects, including development projects funded from the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share of local government units or supported by funds released directly to the City Government, projects funded from locally-generated resources which are implemented within the territorial jurisdiction of Naga City.

**SECTION 4. MEETINGS AND OCCULAR INSPECTIONS.** The Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) shall convene every third week of the month, however, the Chairman may call for an emergency meeting as the need arises.

The PMC shall conduct regular ocular inspection of all projects as stated in Section 3, upon coordination with the implementing agency/organization.

The Secretariat shall prepare a monthly report to be submitted to the City Mayor for his information and guidance.

**SECTION 5. FUNDING.** The operation of the City Project Monitoring Committee shall be provided with a yearly budget to be taken from the 20% Local Development Fund.


**SECTION 6. COMPENSATION AND REMUNERATION** – Members of this Committee, Secretariat and Technical Working Group shall be entitled to an honorarium of Seven Hundred Pesos (P700.00) per meeting chargeable against the funds of the Committee as provided for under Section 5 herein.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
