EXECUTIVE ORDER 2014-014-B

FURTHER EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE NAGA CITY COUNCIL FOR THE WELFARE AND PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (NCCWPC) AND INCORPORATING THERETO THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT COORDINATING COMMITTEE (ECCDCC):-

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State under Article XV Section 3(2) of the 1987 Philippine Constitution to defend the right of children to assistance, including proper care and nutrition, and special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, cruelty, exploitation, and other conditions prejudicial to their development;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular 2002-121 enjoins all Local Chief Executives to organize a Local Council for the Protection of Children;

WHEREAS, Section 8 (c) of Republic Act No. 8990, otherwise known as the "The Early Childhood Care and Development Act" mandates the creation of an Early Childhood Care and Development Committee;

WHEREAS, since the NCCWPC and the ECCDCC have the same objectives, both shall function as one to avoid confusion and duplication;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (2iii) of the Local Government Code empowers the City Mayor to issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order the following:

Section 1. COMPOSITION OF THE NCCWPC. – The membership of the NCCWPC is hereby being expanded to be composed of following:

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Section 2. SECRETARIAT. The Chairperson of the Council shall designate/appoint the secretariat. The Secretariat shall provide administrative and technical support services.

Section 3. FUNCTIONS. The Naga City Council for the Welfare and Protection of Children shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate plans, programs and policies for children that are gender-fair, culturally relevant and responsive to the needs of diverse groups of children from 0 to below 18 years of age;
2. Prepare AAFP for children and recommend appropriations to the Sanggunian;
3. Provide coordinative linkages with other agencies and institutions in the planning, monitoring and evaluation of plans for children;
4. Provide technical assistance and recommend financial support to Barangay Council for the Protection of Children;
5. Establish and maintain database on children in the city/municipality;
6. Foster Education of every child;
7. Advocate for the establishment and maintenance of playgrounds, day care centers and other facilities necessary for child and youth development;
8. Recommend local legislations promoting child survival, protection, participation and development, especially on the quality of television shows, media prints and coverage, which are detrimental to children, and with appropriate funding support;
9. Assist children in need of special protection and refer cases filed against child abusers to proper agencies/institutions;
10. Conduct capability building programs to enhance knowledge and skills in handling children's program;
11. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the program and submit quarterly status reports to PCPC;
12. Performs such other functions as provided for in the ECCD and other child related laws.

Section 4. MEETINGS. The NCCWPC shall conduct quarterly meetings and special meetings, the agenda of which shall include policies/programs/projects/activities relative to the promotion of the rights and welfare of children. Minutes of said meetings shall be prepared by the Secretariat with the corresponding attendance sheet attached to the minutes.



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Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances inconsistent with this Executive Order are repealed and/or modified accordingly.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
