EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2014-027

**RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING BOARD (NCUDHB):**

**WHEREAS**, Section 8, Article 6 of Ordinance No. 98-033 mandates the creation of the Naga City Urban Development and Housing Board (NCUDHB) which acts as the city's arm in the implementation and monitoring of pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7279 and ordinance No. 98-003;

**WHEREAS**, the same section speaks of appointment by the City Mayor of Board Members from the private sector;

**WHEREAS**, received by the Office of the City Mayor on 27 June 2014 is a letter dated 25 June 2014 from Mr. Ramiro I. Samar, Chairperson of the Naga City People's Council endorsing the list of 7 city accredited non-government organizations in which 5 were selected to represent their sector in the Board;

**WHEREAS**, under Executive Order No. 2013-021, "Reconstituting The Naga City Urban Development and Housing Board," issued on August 19, 2013, there were NGO representatives included in the Order not duly accredited by the City Government of Naga;

**WHEREAS**, there is also a change of representation from the Liga ng mga Barangay and the City Treasurer's Office, to be represented by the new Liga President, Hon. Vidal Castillo, and Ms. Gregoria Nilda B. Abonal, Acting City Treasurer, respectively;

**WHEREAS**, in order to rectify this, there is a need to re-organize specifically, the composition of the Naga City Urban Development and Housing Board's non-government organization representatives and the representatives from the Liga ng mga Barangay and the City Treasurer's Office, so that the Board can effectively carry out its functions for the good and welfare of the constituents of the City of Naga;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT**, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the Naga City Urban Development and Housing Board (NCUDHB) to be composed of the following:

**Section 1. Composition.** The Naga City Urban Development and Housing Board (NCUDHB) is hereby reorganized, now to be composed of the following:

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From the government sector

- Hon. Mila S.D. Raquid- Arroyo, Chairman, Committee on Urban Poor Affairs
- Hon. David Casper Nathan A. Sergio, Chairman, Committee on Land Use
- Hon. Ray-an Cydrick G. Rentoy, Chairman, Committee On Laws and Ordinances
- Hon. Vidal Castillo, Liga ng mga Barangay President
- Engr. Rolando S.I. Campillos, Acting Head, Housing and Settlements Development Office
- Engr. Leon B. Palmiano IV, City Engineer
- Engr. Ramon R. Albeus, City Assessor
- Ms. Gregoria Nilda B. Abonal, Acting City Treasurer
- Mr. Jaime Reblando, City Social Welfare and Development Officer
- Mr. Wilfredo B. Prilles, Jr., City Planning and Development Officer

From the Private Sector

Five (5) representatives of the largest accredited urban poor federation or organization in Naga City duly elected in accordance with their constitution and/or by-laws, namely:

- Mr. Danilo B. Ludovice, President, NCUPFI
- Mr. Laurencio A. Salbellena, Vice President, NCUPFI
- Mr. Antonio G. Dela Cruz, Secretary, NCUPFI
- Mr. Romulo B. Pagao, P.I.O., NCUPFI
- Mr. Zosimo O. Requejo, Ex-Officio Officer, NCUPFI

Five (5) representatives of non-government organizations and people's organizations engaged in community organizing and other activities for the development of urban poor communities in Naga City.

- Representative from the Family Planning Organization of the Philippines (FPOP)
- Representative from Sentrong Alternatibong Lingap Panlegal (SALIGAN)
- Representative from Kolping Society of the Philippines, Inc. (KSPI)
- Representative from Gawad Kalinga Foundation
- Representative from Associates in Research and Community Empowerment (ACRES)

**Section 2. Term of Office.** The members of the Board shall serve for a term to expire noon of June 30, 2016, provided that only representatives from the urban poor federation, non-government organizations and people's organizations with no previous conviction or pending cases of crimes involving moral turpitude, and recommended by the Naga City People's Council may be appointed.

**Section 3. Schedule of Meeting.** The Board shall have a regular meeting once a month which will be in the afternoon of every **First Tuesday** of the month and every month



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
thereafter. The Chairperson may call on a special meeting after its regular monthly meeting if there are issues that need immediate disposition by the Board;

**Section 4. Rules of Procedure.** The board shall choose a chairperson from among themselves and promulgate its own internal rules of procedure.


**Section 5. Termination.** The City Mayor shall, upon recommendation of the urban poor federation or organization or non-government organizations concerned, terminate the appointment of any member on any just or valid cause.

**Section 6.** This Executive Order Shall be effective immediately.
