#### Executive Order 2014-032

CREATING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE ADB-JFPR TA 8493 PHI: CLIMATE RESILIENCE AND GREEN GROWTH IN CRITICAL WATERSHEDS OF NINE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGUs) INCLUDING THE CITY OF NAGA:

WHEREAS, the Climate Change Act of 2009 (RA 9729) and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 (RA 10121) mandate all LGUs to mainstream climate change and disaster risk reduction concerns into the LGUs development plans and programs particularly the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) and the Comprehensive Development Plan;

WHEREAS, climate change impacts are beginning to intensify and are anticipated to increase their future threats to the safety and welfare of population, the integrity of natural and physical assets and the growth and development of the economy;

WHEREAS, the fast pace of urban development in the City of Naga is increasing pressure to and exceeding the existing capacity of infrastructure and natural drainage system resulting in more serious flooding;

WHEREAS, the City of Naga is prone to natural disasters particularly flooding which is expected to intensify due to increasing population and environment/natural resources degradation;

WHEREAS, it becomes imperative for the City of Naga to institute policies, plans and programs to adapt to and mitigate the impacts of climate change over the short, medium and long-term, and to avoid, reduce and prepare for natural disasters affecting the city;

WHEREAS, the City of Naga has been selected as one of the pilot LGUs to receive Technical Assistance from ADB-JPR and Climate Change Commission on Resilience and Green Growth in Critical Watersheds Project;

WHEREAS, the City of Naga signed a Memorandum of Agreement with the Climate Change Commission to jointly undertake the Project on Climate Change Resilience and Green Growth and;



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WHEREAS, the Technical Assistance will capacitate the City of Naga in addressing the issues and threats of climate change and disaster risks;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order:

Section 1. Creation. The Naga City Climate Resilience and Green Growth Project Technical Working Group are hereby created.

**Section 2. Composition.** The following shall be the composition of the Technical Working Group (TWG):

Other offices may be called upon to participate in the TWG on occasional basis.



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Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities. The TWG shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1) Act as the over-all coordinating and implementing body for the Project's agreed upon plans and activities related to the conduct of various technical studies and surveys, data and information gathering and generation, local stakeholders and community and consultations, policy and plan preparation, pilot project selection and implementation, and formalization and legitimization of project outputs;
- 2) Serve as the main technical and administrative facilitator with other relevant LGU offices and national government agency representatives;
- 3) Provide information and other available materials to the Project Team as well as extend assistance in data gathering and interview surveys;
- 4) Advise and guide the Project Team in their field visits and in the selection of stakeholders for consultation; and
- 5) Provide secretariat support in the conduct of workshops and consultations with stakeholders.

**Section 4. Creation of Subcommittees.** To facilitate the work of the TWG and its counterpart consultants, the following subcommittees shall be created:


- 1) Subcommittee on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Assessment and Planning
- 2) Subcommittee on GHG Inventory, Assessment and Planning
- 3) Subcommittee on Environment and Natural Resources Assessment and Management Planning
- 4) Subcommittee on Capacity Assessment and Capacity Building
- 5) Subcommittee on GIS Mapping
- 6) Subcommittee on Pilot Project and Project Monitoring and Evaluation

LGU offices may have representatives in more than one committee that are relevant to their functions and responsibilities. Membership in the different subcommittees will be decided upon by the TWG en banc.

Section 5. Role of Other LGU Offices and Units. Where appropriate and relevant to the effective implementation and attainment of the objectives of the Project, the relevant LGU offices/units and or staff/personnel maybe mobilized and requested to provide technical, administrative, information, documentary, operational and/or physical support and assistance to the TWG and the Project Consultants.



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Section 6. Role of National Agency Representatives. Local representatives of national agencies shall be mobilized and engaged for technical, information, research, and administrative coordination and support. The TWG shall identify and make the necessary representation and coordination with these national agencies in specific activities and programs that would be conducted by the Project.

Section 7. Role of Local Barangays. Local barangay officials shall be consulted and involved in relevant activities of the Project. They shall also extend the necessary assistance and support to activities related to the Project. The TWG shall provide the necessary facilitation and coordination with the respective barangays that would be involved in any of the project's activities.

Section 8. Budgetary Support. The City of Naga may provide resources in terms of cash or in kind to support the meetings of the TWG and the field activities of its members. Funds to be contributed in the conduct of activities of the TWG within the city will be subject to the approval of the Mayor and/or by Sanggunian Panglunsod.

Section 9. Technical Assistance Support and Participation. The TWG and/or its members shall be allowed to receive, participate and utilize any external resources, grants and equipment and participate in any technical assistance training, field visits and tours that may be identified and developed in the course of the implementation of the Project.

Section 10. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
