EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2015-011

RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY ANTI-SMOKE BELCHING UNIT:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Memorandum Circular No. 2003-13, the City of Naga was designated as the pilot Airshed Area of Region V;

WHEREAS, cognizant of the thrust of the City Government to sustain the good health and welfare of the citizenry, there is a need to reconstitute a unit which plans and implements appropriate actions for maintaining clean air throughout the city pursuant to Ordinance No. 99-084 "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT PLYING THE HIGHWAYS, ROADS AND STREETS OR OPERATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NAGA TO UNDERGO SMOKE TESTING TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE ENRO FOR THE PURPOSES OF ANTI-SMOKE BELCHING AND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL";

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Composition - The Naga City Anti-Smoke Belching Unit is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Chairman: City Mayor
Vice Chairman and Action Officer: City Environment and Natural Resources Officer (ENRO)

Members:

Government Sector:

- Technical Staff, City ENRO
- Representative, EMB-DENR-V
- Representative, Naga City Police Office (NCPO)
- Representative, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)
- Representative, Land Transportation Office (LTO)

Private Sector:

- Representative, Naga City People's Council (NCPC)
- Representative, Prime Movers for Peace and Progress Association, Inc. (PRIMO)

Section 2. Functions and Responsibilities. The Naga City Anti-Smoke Belching Unit shall have the following functions and responsibilities;

1. Plan for the operation of the Roadside Monitoring and Apprehension along the entrance/exit roads in the City of Naga;
2. Coordinate with pertinent line agencies;
3. Conduct public awareness campaigns and invite the participation of the people from the academe in disseminating information relevant to the city's environmental programs;
4. Perform such other functions in pursuance of the above.

Section 3. Meeting. The members of the Naga City Anti-Smoke Belching Unit shall meet once every quarter or as often as need arises for the performance of its functions and responsibilities, to be called by the Chairman thru the Vice Chairman and Action Officer.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
