**CREATING THE NAGA CITY MENTAL HEALTH CARE SUPPORT
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:**

WHEREAS, the City of Naga should never stop its efforts in making the city a truly livable one and worthy of being called as "An Maogmang Lugar";

WHEREAS, one of the concerns of the City Government of Naga is addressing the needs of abandoned mentally challenged/unstable persons;

WHEREAS, the said sector should always be included in the city's governance and should not be left behind;

WHEREAS, cognizant of the city government's steadfast advocacy to protect and maintain the welfare of the citizenry, there is a need to create a group that shall ensure that abandoned mentally challenged/unstable persons in the city are provided with the adequate and proper assistance they deserve as human beings;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the power vested in me by law do hereby order:

Section 1. Creation. In order to address the aforementioned points, the Naga City Mental Health Care Support Executive Committee is hereby created.

Section 2. Composition. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

Section 3. Functions and Responsibilities. The Committee shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

- Establish a database or inventory per barangay of abandoned mentally challenged/unstable persons in the City of Naga and regularly update the same;
- Plan necessary steps and procedures on how to help and support such persons with special needs;
- Administer regular medical and mental support;
- Collaborate with BMC, particularly the Dea Susano J. Rodriguez Memorial Mental Hospital and other pertinent agencies;
- To meet at least once every quarter, to be called by the Mayor;
- Perform such other functions relevant to the proper implementation of this Executive Order.

Section 4. Effectivity - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
