EXECUTIVE ORDER 2016-018

CREATING A TASK FORCE TO EVALUATE THE PERSISTENT INFESTATION AND PROLIFERATION OF HOUSEFLIES AT BARANGAYS PACOL, CAROLINA, PANICUASON, SAN ISIDRO, AND CARARAYAN, DETERMINE PROBABLE CAUSES AND SOURCES, AND RECOMMEND INTERVENTIONS IN AID OF LEGISLATION AND REGULATORY MEASURES AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF:-

Whereas, Section 455, 2 (iii) of the Local Government Code of the Philippines empowers Chief Executives of Local Government Units to "enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the city and in the exercise of appropriate corporate powers such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances";

Whereas, City Ordinance No. 92-048, as amended, prescribes the requirements for the construction and operation of poultry houses or domestic pigpens as well as penalties for violation thereof;

Whereas, recently, infestation and proliferation of houseflies in at least five (5) barangays of the City of Naga have affected households, businesses especially the resorts and tourism establishments as well as the tourists themselves, putting the entire city in bad light;

Now, therefore, I, John G. Bongat, Mayor of the City of Naga, do hereby order:

Section 1. For brevity, the newly-created group shall be called "Task Force ALIS" (Anti-Langaw Infestation Service).

Section 2. The following shall be the primary goals of the Task Force:

1. To determine the extent and probable causes of the proliferation of houseflies primarily in the five affected barangays;
2. To recommend to the City Mayor and the SP appropriate interventions to mitigate and control the spread of houseflies in the affected barangays;
3. To recommend to the Sangguniang Panlungsod appropriate regulatory measures for inclusion in the draft ordinance regulating the establishment, expansion, and operation of poultry and hog raising

farms in Naga and providing the appropriate penalties for violations thereof;

4. To serve as the composite inspection team of the City Government as regards issue of housefly proliferation in affected barangays.

Section 3. The following departments, offices, bodies, and organizations, represented by their respective heads or official representatives shall make up Task Force ALIS:

Section 4. The Task Force shall have the following functions:

1. Identify and verify the location of commercial poultry and hog farms operating within the five barangays of Pacol, Carolina, Panicuason, San Isidro, and Cararayan;



2. Conduct thorough inspection of poultry and hog farms within the target barangays, including all facilities and determine their level of compliance in mitigating the germination, growth, and proliferation of houseflies;
3. Formulate a detailed report on the status and condition of the proliferation of houseflies in the five identified barangays within 30 days from issuance of this executive order;
4. Submit recommendations to the City Mayor and the Sangguniang Panlungsod on proposed interventions to control and eliminate the spread of houseflies through the creation of a comprehensive city ordinance within 60 days from issuance of this executive order, taking into consideration land use restrictions, the design of poultry/piggery buildings, the proper disposal and treatment of poultry and piggery manure/solid waste and waste water, their possible conversion into organic fertilizer, among others;
5. Regularly monitor the compliance of poultry and hog farms operating within the five barangays with local and national regulations;
6. Recommend revisions or changes to existing city ordinances, programs, and policies to prevent similar incidents from occurring;
7. Recommend regulatory actions on non-compliant poultry and hog raising farm operators.

Section 5. This executive order shall take effect immediately.
