



Executive Order No. 2016-025

RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD:-

Whereas, by virtue of Republic Act Nos. 6975 and 8551, mandates the establishment of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) in every local government which serves as the central receiving entity for any citizen's complaint against any officers and members of the Naga City Police Office;

Whereas, under Peace and Order Council Resolution no. 2010-06 adopted on July 26, 2010 confirmed the composition of PLEB members and Sanggunian Resolution no. 2010-230 adopted last August 3, 2010 designated Councilor Jose Tuason as SP Representative to the PLEB;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, City Mayor of Naga, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order for the reconstitution of the Naga City People's Law Enforcement Board, to wit:

Section 1. **Composition** – The Naga City People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Members:

- Hon. Mila S.D. Raquid-Arroyo, SP Representative
- Hon. Jorge I. Salva, Jr., Punong Barangay of Bagumbayan Sur
- Atty. Milagros Francia, Private practitioner
- Col. Jose A. Tuazon (Ret.), Private practitioner
- Mr. J. Antonio Amparado, Private practitioner

Secretariat: Ms. Virginia Pascual, City Director, DILG-Naga

The Chairperson shall be elected from among its members.

Section 2. **Term of office** – the members of the PLEB shall be for a period of three (3) years from assumption of office. Such member shall hold office until his/her successor shall have been chosen and qualified.



The tenure of office of a PLEB member who has been designated as such by virtue of his election to the Sangguniang Panlungsod or his membership with the Liga ng mga Barangay ends upon the expiration of his term of office as Sanggunian member or as Punong Barangay.


Section 3. Funding and Compensation – Membership in the PLEB is a civic duty, however, PLEB members including its designated support staff shall be paid *per diem*. A maintenance and operation fund of the PLEB shall be included in the annual budget of the city

Section 4. Effectivity – This Executive order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
