



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2017-020

CREATING AN EVALUATION COMMITTEE TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE ACTIVITIES OF GRACELAND FOOD INDUSTRIES INC. IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH ITS ZONAL CLASSIFICATION, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, a complaint was lodged before the Ombudsman that the City Government of Naga order the relocation of the operations of Graceland Food Industries Inc. to a more suitable location;

WHEREAS, Graceland Industries Inc., claims that its operations and activities are within the purview of its present zone classification;

WHEREAS, in a conference before the office of the Ombudsman, it was agreed by all parties concerned to evaluate Graceland Industries Inc., to determine whether its operations are allowable under the existing land use classification of its present location, and therefore, may be allowed to continue to operate its business therein;

NOW THEREFORE, I JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Composition - The Evaluation Committee is hereby organized to be composed of the following:

The Committee shall convene within a reasonable time from the time the Office of the Mayor has been notified by the complaining parties that their counsel, Atty. Carlos Cortes, has already arrived from the United States.

Section 2. Functions – The Evaluation Committee shall have the following functions:

1. Inspect and evaluate Graceland Food Industries Inc.'s activities and operations at Graceland Building, Barlin Street, Naga City, 4400, Camarines Sur;
2. Determine whether such activities are allowable under the present classification of the land where it stands;
3. Draft and submit a report of such evaluation before the City Mayor's Office, furnishing copies of which to the Office of the Deputy Ombudsman for Luzon;
4. Perform such other functions incidental and necessary to the proper implementation of this order.

Section 3. Effectivity – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.


