

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2019-034

RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, received by this office are the following resolutions from the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Peace and Order Council and Liga ng mga Barangay designating their respective members as representatives to the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB):

- a. Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution No. 2019-212 favorably recommending the appointment of Honorable City Councilor Mila S.D. Raquid-Arroyo as the official representative of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to the People's Law Enforcement Board;
- b. Peace and Order Council Resolution No. 2019-018 designating Atty. Milagros Francia, Mrs. Norma S. San Jose and Mr. Ferdinand Sia as official representatives of the Naga City Peace and Order Council to the People's Law Enforcement Board; and,
- c. Liga ng mga Barangay Resolution No. 2019-09 recognizing Punong Barangay Alfonso R. Rodriguez as the official representative of Liga ng mga Barangay in the People's Law Enforcement Board

WHEREAS, Republic Act Nos. 6975 and 8551, mandates the establishment of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) in every local government which serves as the central receiving entity for any citizen's complaint against any officers and members of the Naga City Police Office;

WHEREAS, the People's Law Enforcement Board empowers the people against abusive and erring policemen;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Naga City People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Mrs. Norma S. San Jose, POC Member

The Chairperson shall be elected from among its members.

SECTION 2. TERM OF OFFICE. The members of the PLEB shall be for a period of three (3) years from assumption of office. They shall hold office until their successors shall have been chosen and qualified. However, the tenure of office of a PLEB member who has been designated as such by virtue of his election to the Sangguniang Panlungsod or his membership with the Liga ng mga Barangay ends upon the expiration of his term of office as Sanggunian member or as Punong Barangay.

Section 3. OBSERVERS AND NON-VOTING MEMBERS. For furtherance of transparency and good governance, the following shall form part of the People's Law Enforcement Board as observers and non-voting members thereof:

2. Atty. Franco Fermin B. Avila


SECTION 4. FUNDING AND COMPENSATION. Membership in the PLEB is a civic duty. However, PLEB members, including its designated support staff and observers/non-voting members, shall be paid *per diem*. A maintenance and operation fund of the PLEB shall be included in the annual budget of the city.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
