3. Metro Naga Chamber of Commerce and Industry
4. Independent Component City Agriculture and Fisheries Council
5. Multi-Agri-Forest and Community Development Cooperative

- c) Ar. Hilda Charito A. Beltran, United Architects of the Philippines

SECTION 2. TERM OF OFFICE. The members of the Board shall serve a term co-terminus with the term of the City Mayor and the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

SECTION 3. HONORARIA TO PRIVATE SECTOR MEMBERS. Members of the Board, except those from the government sector, shall receive an

honorarium to defray their expenses in attending the functions of the Board in such amount as it may determine, to be included in its Annual Budget.

SECTION 4. INTERNAL RULES OF PROCEDURE. The Board shall promulgate its internal rules of procedure, including the guidelines on possible expulsion of erring members from the Board.


To declare a quorum in any meeting of the Board, however, it is sufficient that at least two each from the government, the urban poor sector and the non-government sector be present.
