



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2021-007

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CREATING THE JOINT INFRASTRUCTURE TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the City Government of Naga is aggressive in building new roads and pursuing infrastructure projects to ease traffic congestion and boost economic growth in the City of Naga;

WHEREAS, in the construction of new buildings and thoroughfares, there are issues and concerns that require the cooperation of other stakeholders in their resolution, particularly in the laying down of pipelines and the installation of poles on roads and other infrastructures;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **NELSON S. LEGACION**, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. JOINT INFRASTRUCTURE TASK FORCE. The Joint Infrastructure Task Force is herein created with the following composition:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The Joint Infrastructure Task Force shall be responsible for:

1. Inspection of project site to ensure that no water line and electric pole shall be affected by the infrastructure project or, if there will be any, provide urgent intervention so as not to disrupt water and electric supply in Naga;
2. Ensure that the groundworks for installation of water lines and electric poles can be done simultaneously with the implementation of the city's infrastructure projects so as to enhance efficiency and avoid additional costs and burden on the part of the city, of the MNWD and/or CASURECO II; and,
3. Develop a close working relationship between and among the City Government of Naga, Metro Naga Water District and Camarines Sur Electric Cooperative II, particularly in the execution of development projects.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
