ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VAGRANTS IN THE CITY OF NAGA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF: -

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. - VAGRANCY. - (a) Any person having no apparent means of subsistence, who has the physical ability to work and neglects to apply himself/herself to some lawful calling;

- b. Any person seen loitering or wandering about public or semi-public building or place or tramping or wandering about the country or the streets without visible means of support;
- c. Any idle or dissolute person who lodges in houses of ill-fame, ruffians or pimps and those who habitually associate with prostitutes;
- d. Any person who, without the lawful purpose found loitering around the school campus and school premises;
- e. Any person who, not being included in the provisions of the Revised Penal Code, shall be found loitering in any inhabited or uninhabited place belonging to another without any lawful or justifiable purpose, shall be deemed and are considered vagrant;

SECTION 2. - PENALTY. - Any person or persons deemed vagrant upon conviction of the proper court shall be punishable by a fine of not less than P20.00 nor more than P200.00 or by imprisonment of not less than Five (5) days but not more than 30-days or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 3. - Any resolution, ordinance or ordinances which are inconsistent hereof is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
