ORDINANCE NO. 377

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS IN THE MT. ISAROG NATIONAL PARK AT PANICUASON, NAGA CITY, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR: -

Be it ordained by the municipal Board of the City of Naga, that:

- **SECTION 1.** No person shall cut, destroy, damage or gather the timber or other forest products or forest cover in the Mt. Isarog National Park at Panicuason, Naga City, or shall mutilate, deface or destroy objects of natural beauty or of scenic value therein;
- **SECTION 2.** No person shall occupy or clear any portion of said National Park or shall construct any house, shack or any other edifice therein;
- **SECTION 3.** No persons shall pollute, contaminate, litter or otherwise dirty the waters with the human or animal waste, garbage and other foreign matters or shall divert or appropriate the waters;
- **SECTION 4.** No person shall hunt, capture, kill or attempt to take, capture or kill, willfully disturb or drive away any kind of birds, fish or animals within the National Park;
- **SECTION 5.** The above sections shall not apply if the person has a permit or license from proper government authorities or if the purpose is to develop the place into a resort or tourist spot as approved by the City Mayor, the Municipal Board and the City Engineer after prior consultation with the Director of Parks and Wildlife;
- **SECTION 6.** Violation of this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment of not less than four (4) months or more than six (6) months or a fine of not more than Two Hundred (P200.00) Pesos or both such fine at the discretion of the court.
 - **SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
