ORDINANCE NO. 92-050

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION/SALE OF POTABLE WATER IN THE CITY OF NAGA, AUTHORIZING THE FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE THEREOF AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF: -

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. - TITLE. - This ordinance shall be known as the "NAGA CITY ABATTOIR WATER DISTRIBUTION ORDINANCE";

SECTION 2. - DEFINITION OF TERMS. - The following words and phrases as used inn this ordinance shall mean as follows:

- a) TANKER OR LORRY. Shall refer to a galvanized iron water container pulled by a motorized vehicle use in transporting water from one point to another;
- b) POTABLE ABATTOIR WATER. Refers to the water pumped out of the deep well at the Naga City Abattoir;
- c) BULK SALE. refers to the sale of potable abattoir water in volumes in a given period of time.
- d) VOLUME. Refers to the sale of potable abattoir water in one or more cubic meters at one time.

SECTION 3. - WATER DISTRIBUTION. - Aside from its regular use in the operation of the City of Naga abattoir, it is hereby authorized to distribute the potable water for residential and commercial purposes as follows:

a) RESIDENTIAL CONSUMERS. – Any person, association or group who would like to avail of the potable abattoir water shall file an application with the Naga City Abattoir Manager. Upon payment of the required application and installation fees at the City Treasurer's Office, the City Abattoir shall install the water line connection from the main water to the meter of a residential house of the applicant.

The applicant shall provided all the materials needed to tap from the main to the applicant residence.

 COMMERCIAL CONSUMERS – any person association, group of person who fetch water from the Naga City Abattoir by the use of tanker shall pay the amount as scheduled.

The necessary contract papers in both instances above-mentioned shall be prepared by the City Abattoir Office shall entered into by and between the City Mayor or his authorized representative(s) and the consumers.

SECTION 4. - FEES AND CHARGES. - The following fees and charges for the sale of potable abattoir water, application and installation of water connections are hereby prescribed and authorized, to wit:

a. Residential Consumers

a1 Application fee	P 20.00
a2 Installation fee	5.00/linear meter
a3 Minimum rate	35.00 (first 10 cu. m.)
11-15 cu.m.	
1.75/cu.m.	
15 cu. m. and above	2.25/cu.m.

b. Commercial Consumers

P 500.00
20.00/tanker
35.00/tanker
50.00/tanker

SECTION 5. - COLLECTION OF FEES AND CHARGES. - The Collection and fees and charges shall be done by the City Treasurer of his duly authorized representative subject existing Government Treasury and Accounting rules and Regulations.

SECTION 6. – REGULATIONS. - No person(s) shall be allowed to offer for sale or to be engaged in business of selling potable water to any buyer/customer who is engaged in transporting and selling the same to neighbor municipalities of the City of Naga.

Bulk Sale of potable water shall only be allowed at the Naga City Abattoir, Barangay Del Rosario, Naga City;

SECTION 7. – PENALTY. - Any person or persons found guilty of violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of not less than FIVE HUNDRED (P 500.00) PESOS but not more than ONE THOUSAND (P 1,000.00) PESOS or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month but not more than six (6) months or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 8. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - An ordinance, rules and regulations found inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and/or modified accordingly;

SECTION 9. – EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
