ORDINANCE NO. 92-059

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 107, S. 1952, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE HANGING OR SPREADING OF LAUNDRY OVER SIDEWALKS, PUBLIC ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES:

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. – Section 3 of Ordinance No. 107, S. 1952 is hereby amended, now to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. - Any violations of the provisions of this ordinance shall subject the offender to a fine with the following scheduled:

For the first offense a fine of One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos For the second offense a fine of Three hundred (P 300.00) Pesos

For the third offense a fine of not more than Five hundred (500.00)

Pesos Or imprisonment of not more than six (6)

months or both such fine and

Imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 2. – For purposes of this ordinance, the word "laundry shall mean clothes, clothing materials and other articles intended either to be dried or sunned and other similar purposes;

SECTION 3. – SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason or reasons any part of the provisions of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. – REPEALING AND AMENDATORY CLAUSE – Any ordinance and administrative regulations or parts or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. – EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
