**ORDINANCE NO. 94-101**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 94-063 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VENDING INSIDE TRIMOBILE STATIONS AND ALL WAITING SHEDS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF: -**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

**SECTION 1.** - SECTION 2 of Ordinance No. 94-063 is hereby amended, now to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. - PROHIBITION. - Vending of any kind or in an manner is hereby prohibited inside all trimobile stations and waiting sheds within the radius of three (3) meters on both sides and one (1) meter at the back from the perimeter line or edge of said structures, within the jurisdiction of the City of Naga";

**SECTION 2.** - SECTION 4 of same Ordinance No. 94-063 is hereby amended, now to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. - PENALTIES. - (a) Any violation of this ordinance shall be penalized with administrative penalties consisting of fines to be imposed as follows:

First Offense	P 200.00
Second Offense	500.00
Third & Succeeding Offenses	1,000.00

- b. Upon apprehension, the goods or items being sold by the vendor shall be confiscated by the apprehending authority and brought to the nearest police station for safekeeping. They shall be released only upon payment of the requisite fine except those owned by vendors apprehended for the third or more times in which case their goods shall be forfeited in favor of the government.
- c. Violators upon apprehension shall be issued with a Violator's Citation Ticket and must be redeemed with the PNP Traffic Bureau within forty-eight (48) hours upon receipt.
- d. All fines from Administrative Penalty shall be paid directly to the city Treasurer's Office with corresponding notation of the citation ticket. The City Treasurer may detail a collector in the Public Market Office for this purpose.
- e. Failure on the part of the violator to redeem his citation ticket within the prescribed period, confiscated goods shall be forfeited in favor of the

government, who in turn shall distribute them to charitable purpose or institution in accordance with appropriate procedures.

**SECTION 3. - REPEALING CLAUSE.** - Ordinances, resolutions and issuances or part or parts thereof in consistent with this ordinance are hereby modified accordingly.

**SECTION 4.** - This ordinance shall take effect upon the approval and publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.
