ORDINANCE NO. 96-039

AN ORDINANCE ORDAINING THE CLEARING OF ROAD LOTS AND PASSAGEWAYS INSIDE THE PEÑAFRANCIA MITRA AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREOF: -

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. - POLICY. - It is the policy of the City Government to clear all road lots and passageways in the City of Naga particularly at the Peñafrancia Mitra at Barangay Peñafrancia so as to allow the free flow of vehicles, particularly the fire trucks to facilitate fire assistance.

SECTION 2. - SCOPE. - This ordinance shall embrace the road lots and passageways found in the property purchased by the City Government from the Archbishop of Caceres known as the Peñafrancia Mitra properties.

SECTION 3. - It shall be unlawful for any person to construct or occupy any portion of any of the road lots or passageways identified as such inside the Peñafrancia Mitra property. Provided that any person or lot owner now occupying or having any construction beyond his residential lot, whether it be a fence, or part of his building of whatever kind or nature is given a period up to December 31, 1996 to remove such construction. Provided, further, that should such person fails or refuses to remove such construction or edifice, then the city government may cause to remove such construction and the cost to be charged against the person who owns or caused such construction which is to be removed.

SECTION 4. - PENALTIES. - Any person who construct or occupy any portion of any of the road lots and passageways or violates this ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:

- a. For the first offense shall suffer an administrative fine of P500.00;
- b. For the second offense an administrative fine of P1,500.00;
- c. For a third offense, to suffer an imprisonment for a period of one (1) month and a fine of P1,000.00;
- d. For a fourth offense, to suffer imprisonment for a period of two (2) months and a fine of P1,500.00.

SECTION 5. - EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
