ORDINANCE NO. 96-046

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 (17) OF ORDINANCE NO. 582, SERIES OF 1977 BY ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES BETWEEN BARANGAY CAROLINA AND BARANGAY PACOL, BOTH OF THE CITY OF NAGA:-

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. - SECTION 2 (17) of Ordinance No. 582, Series of 1977, defining the boundaries of Barangay Pacol, upon petition of the affected residents pursuant to Chapter 2, Sec. 6 of the Local Government Code in relation with Rule II, Article 6 and 14 (e) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code of 1991 is hereby amended and the boundaries altered as follows:

"SECTION 2.(17) - BARANGAY PACOL. - The Barangay of Pacol comprise the territorial jurisdiction delimited by the following boundaries:

- NORTH: From MBM eastward running to the centerline of Calauag River to MBM 25 to MBM 26;
- EAST: From MBM southward to BBM 30 then to eastward to center of crossing Naga Carolina Road and Carolina Nursery Caromatig Road then along center line of Carolina Nursery Caromatig Road to nearest point from this Road to BBM 29;
- SOUTH: From MBM 29 Westward to BBM 30;
- WEST: From BBM 23 Northward to BBM 22 then westward to BBM 21 northward to BBM 20 then to MBM 24".

SECTION 2. - The plebiscite to be conducted by the COMELEC in accordance with the procedure laid down in Art. 14 (e) of the same Implementing Rules shall be made on November 4, 1996 upon the residents of the area directly affected by the alteration of the boundary;

SECTION 3. - EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect upon the ratification of the people concerned and after publication in a local newspaper of general circulation in the City of Naga.
