



## ORDINANCE NO. 2002-056

## AN ORDINANCE PENALIZING ACTS OF VANDALISM TO CABLE T.V. EQUIPMENT: -

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

**SECTION 1.** - TITLE. - This ordinance shall be known as "the Cable T.V. Equipment Anti-Vandalism Ordinance".

**SECTION 2.** - DEFINITION OF TERMS. - "Cable TV equipment", for purposes of this ordinance shall mean and include the following:

(a)	a) Main Transmission Lines – (a-1) Co-axial Cables – (a-2) Fiber Optics		Closures
			Optical

(c) Subscribers Drop Lines

Receivers

- (d) Amplifiers
- (e) Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS)
- (f) Splitters
- (g) Taps
- (h) Grounding Wire
- (i) Directional Couplers

**SECTION 3.** - ACTS OF VANDALISM CONSTRUED. - For purposes of this ordinance, acts of vandalism shall mean the following intentional acts:

- a. Cutting of Lines
- b. Physical Damaging
- c. Signal Tampering and Interference
- d. Deactivating Without Damaging Equipment
- e. Any other act/s that result/s to the prejudice, damage or disturbance to cable TV equipment as defined in Section 2 hereof.

**SECTION 4.** - PENALTY CLAUSE. - Any person found committing acts of vandalism to cable TV equipment shall suffer a penalty of fine not exceeding P5,000.00 or one (1) year imprisonment or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. If the act is committed by a juridical person, the erring personnel shall be criminally liable therefore. Every violation of this ordinance shall be construed as a distinct and separate offense and shall be punishable as herein provided.

**SECTION 5.** - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - Any provision/s of this ordinance or portion/s thereof found to be violative of the constitution or invalid shall not impair the other provisions or part/s thereof which shall continue to be in force and in effect.

**SECTION 6.** - REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are consistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 7.** – EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.
