AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE URBAN RESETTLEMENT SITE LOCATED AT STA. CRUZ, NAGA CITY, AS JOLLY NEIGHBORS SUBDIVISION AND ASSIGNING NAMES TO THE STREETS WITHIN SAID PROJECT SITE:-

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Currently, the streets within the Urban Resettlement Site have no legislated names and are being assigned ones that have been proposed by the Jolly Neighborhood Association, Inc. (JNAI) and favorably endorsed by the Barangay Council of Sta Cruz.

Following several consultations and hearings, it has also been agreed that seven (7) of the principal and minor streets are being named after local heroes based on researches done by historian and academist Jose V. Barrameda, Jr.

- 1) **IGNACIO B. MELITON** - His noble contribution was, among others, that he had given a good name to the Province of Camarines Sur when he served as representative during the 10th Philippine Legislature of the House of Representatives. His lifelong interest in Bicol history and culture became manifest in his collection of books, pamphlets brochures and articles on Rizaliana. His commitment to history and culture led him to membership in the Philippine Historical Society, Phil. Historical Association, Academia Bicolnon, and other similar groups. He was the first to translate Bicolandia's epic poem, *Handiong*, from Spanish to English. His work "*Mga Sinarakit na Bikolnon*" remains an important source and reference for present-day scholars and researchers on Bicol history. Most of his priceless collection of researches and historical documents can be found at the University of Nueva Caceres Museum and serves as his invaluable legacy to Bicol in general and to Naga City in particular.
- 2) **CASIMIRO F. PERFECTO** - He was instrumental in the advocacy that saw a mini Renaissance of Bikol literature and journalism during the Pre-World War II period. He was also Naga's earliest printer/publisher and operated the great Mariano Perfecto's Imprenta y Liberia Mariana. His contribution to Bicol Letters and the development of the local publishing industry deserves recognition.
- 3) a) **Fabiana Arejola vda. de Reyes**, b) **Antonia Cecilio vda. de Pardo**, c) **Emilia Nisola de Reyes**, d) **Faviana Sierra vda. de Jacob** and e) **Laureana Sierra de Valenciano**. These five Nagueñas were among the eight brave Bicolanas who volunteered their time and material possessions to the cause of Philippine independence. They were called the **DAMAS BENEMERITAS DE LA PATRIA** or simply known as the "National Heroines". This group of bicolanas provided unstinting support to the army of General Ludovico Arejola during the Filipino-American war in Camarines Sur over a hundred years ago.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga that:

SECTION 1. - Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Jolly Neighbors Ordinance of Sta. Cruz, Naga City;"

SECTION 2. - Legal Basis.

2.1 This Ordinance is in accordance with Section 6 (13) (b) of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991 under the heading *Naming of Local Government Units and Public Places and Structures* states that **"the sanggunians of highly urbanized cities may in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction : (2) city roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges."**

Naming the subject streets in this ordinance is an exercise by the City of Naga of its power to name city roads, avenues and the like as provided for in this Section of Republic Act No. 7160.;

2.2 The Revised Guidelines in the Approval or Disapproval in the Naming and Renaming of Streets, Plazas, Public Schools, Buildings, Bridges and Other Public Places issued by the National Historical Institute under transmittal letter from its Executive Director dated 23 August 2007;

SECTION 3. - Definition of Terms

3.1 Urban Resettlement Site - the project site located at Barangay Sta. Cruz, with boundaries as follows: NW with the Municipality of Camaligan and Lot 2363 (Cad. 290, Naga Cadastre); SW with Lot 1285 (Cad. 290, Naga Cadastre); NE with Lot 1290-B-6-B (PSD-05-018324); and NS with Lots 1285 (Cad. 290, Naga Cadastre), 1288 (Cad. 290, Naga Cadastre), and 1290-A (PSD-05-003222);

3.2 Circumferential Road -- in the context of this Ordinance, temporary reference given to the major road from Queborac to Abella that cuts across the midsection of the Jolly Neighbors Subdivision; such reference is not meant to officially designate a name under this Ordinance and does not preclude the possibility of such road being assigned a permanent official name in the future;

SECTION 4. - Official Name of the Subdivision. The Urban Resettlement Site described in Section 3.1 above is hereby designated the official name JOLLY NEIGHBORS SUBDIVISION;

SECTION 5. - Official Postal Address. The official postal address of the same site, upon enactment of this ordinance, shall be: Jolly Neighbors Subdivision, Zone 7, Barangay Sta. Cruz, Naga City 4400;

SECTION 6. - New Street Names. The streets within the Jolly Neighbors Subdivision at Barangay Sta. Cruz, City of Naga, are hereby assigned the following names, to wit:

SECTION 7. - The street names or markers shall be in consonance with Section 13 (d) of Ordinance No. 2005-080;

SECTION 8. - Funding Requirement. The amount necessary to cover the cost for the acquisition/fabrication of the street names/markers shall be chargeable against Kulturang Bikolnon allocation while those pertaining to installation, including manpower and labor, shall be covered by the Barangay Council of Sta. Cruz and/or the Jolly Neighborhood Association, Inc.;

SECTION 9. - Repealing Amendatory Clause. All ordinances, rules, regulations and resolutions in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. - Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication in a newspaper of local circulation.
