AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NAGA CITY VOLUNTEERS FOR HEALTH PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND (P800,000.00) PESOS TO COVER THE GRANT OF DAILY STIPEND TO VOLUNTEERS RENDERING SERVICES AT THE NAGA CITY HOSPITAL AND THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE, CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE BALANCE OF THE 2009 SURPLUS:-

On joint and collective motion

**WHEREAS**, at present, there are many graduates of various health courses need to accumulate service hours in health facility for future employment and professional growth, however, most of them render service for free, and some health facilities even exact a fee for the opportunity to render service which in effect taken advantaged of and in some instance forced to shell their own money to accumulate service hours;

**WHEREAS**, given the health facilities of the Naga City Hospital and the Naga City Health Office, there are volunteer workers who fill the shortfall of qualified employees, and help enhancing the city government's health services to its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, given the benefits gained by the city government from the services of the volunteer workers, it is just proper that at the very least, these volunteers be reimbursed for their daily expenses in the form of a fixed daily stipend;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on joint and collective motion;

Be it ordained by the SangguniangPanlungsod of the City of Naga, that:

**SECTION 1.** - Title. - This ordinance shall be known as the "Volunteers for Health Program Ordinance of Naga City";

**SECTION 2.** - Coverage. - This ordinance shall cover all volunteer workers on duty in either the Naga City Hospital or the City Health Office as of January 2010;

**SECTION 3.**-Requirements for Entitlement. - To be entitled to the stipend, a volunteer worker as contemplated under this program must:

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1. Accomplish a Volunteer Worker's Undertaking duly acknowledged by the Chief of the Naga City Hospital or the City Health Officer, copy furnished the City Budget Officer. Said undertaking shall not establish an employee-employer relationship between the volunteer and the city government;
2. Regularly accomplish a Daily Time Record; and
3. Prepare an Accomplishment Report duly signed by the Chief of the Naga City Hospital or the City Health Officer.

**SECTION 4.** - Computation of Stipend. - The stipend shall be computed based on actual days rendered at eight (8) hours per day. In case duty rendered is less than 8 hours, the stipend shall be computed on a per hour basis at the rate of P25.00 per hour, provided, such abbreviated duty shall be duly approved by the concerned Head of Office;

**SECTION 5.** - Funding. - The amount of Eight Hundred Thousand (P800,000.00) Pesos is hereby appropriated for this purpose, chargeable against the balance of the 2009 Surplus;

**SECTION 6.** - Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
