AN ORDINANCE REVERTING TO UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (P212,000.00) FROM INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT OF THE NAGA CITY HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) OF THE SAME TO DRUGS AND MEDICINES EXPENSES, ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) TO OTHER SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS EXPENSES AND TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (P12,000.00) TO HONORARIA OF THE SAID HOSPITAL:-

On joint and collective motion

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga, that:

SECTION 1. - The amount of Two Hundred Twelve Thousand Pesos (P212,000.00) from Information and Communication Technology Equipment of the Naga City Hospital is hereby reverted to unappropriated balance, and appropriating the amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) of the same to Drugs and Medicines Expenses, One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) to Other Supplies and Materials Expenses and Twelve Thousand Pesos (P12,000.00) to Honoraria of the said hospital;

SECTION 2. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
