RESOLUTION CALLING ON THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF NAGA AND THE RIDING PUBLIC THRU THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE AND THE NAGA CITY POLICE OFFICE (NCPO) TO STRICTLY AND EFFECTIVELY MONITOR AND OBSERVE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TRIMOBILE FARE AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE NO. 93-049 OR THE "TRANSPORT AND TRAFFIC CODE OF NAGA" AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2008-055:-

WHEREAS, as mandated by Ordinance No. 93-049 or the "Transport and Traffic Code of Naga City," Section 117 of Ordinance No. 93-049, as amended, is hereby further amended by Ordinance No. 2008-055, with Section 1 fixing the new passenger rates of fare for trimobiles for hire in the City of Naga.

WHEREAS, the rate of fare for trimobiles for hire in the City of Naga shall be P8.00 per regular passenger for the first three (3) kilometers and an additional P0.50 for every succeeding kilometer or a fraction thereof. For students, senior citizens and disabled persons, the discounted fare shall be P6.00 and additional P0.50 for every succeeding kilometer or a fraction thereof provided, that to avail of the discounted rates, senior citizens and students should have a current valid identification card issued by the proper authorities and schools concerned respectively.

WHEREAS, many trimobile drivers do not comply to the said regular fare rate as they charge more than what is stated in Ordinance No. 2008-055.

WHEREAS, complaints about over-charging of trimobile drivers have been repeatedly reported by public passengers of Naga City.

WHEREAS, this resolution does not include trimobiles with special rates such as those that are situated in private subdivisions, and trimobiles that accept rental fees.

WHEREAS, NCPO the City Government of Naga thru the Public Safety Office is requested to conduct an assembly with or issue a memorandum to all the trimobile operators relaying the strict and effective enforcement of regular rates as ordered by Ordinance No. 2008-055.

WHEREAS, NCPO the City Government of Naga thru the Public Safety Office shall also inform the trimobile operators regarding the corresponding penalties given in Ordinance No. 93-049.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Office, NCPO shall strengthen its campaign in active participation of the public through clarifying their responsibility to report to the concerned office those trimobile drivers and operators who violate the Ordinance No. 2008-055.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Office, NCPO shall also emphasize the applicability of the discounted fare rates which is mandated by Memorandum Circular No. 2011-004 entitled "2011 Revised Terms and Conditions of CPC and Providing Penalties for Violations thereof" which states under Condition No. 12-13 that the PUV operator shall grant fare discounts to students during school days and shall cover only those currently enrolled, in Preschool, Elementary, Secondary and Collegiate schools including academic, Vocational and Technical schools duly recognized by the Government, EXCEPT: those of dancing and driving schools, short term courses of seminar type, and post graduate studies (those taking up medicine, law, masteral, doctoral degrees and the like).

WHEREAS, Condition No. 10 of Memorandum Circular No. 2011-004 shall also be relayed to all Naga City PUV operators that refers to the posting of a copy of the fare Matrix in a conspicuous place at their office terminal or waiting stations, and in the interior of each motor vehicle which is in actual service.

WHEREAS, the identification card of the drivers should be visible to the riding public as a source of information of what to report in case a driver violates the Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Chester G. Beluang, unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED to call on the City Government of Naga thru the Public Safety Office and the Naga City Police Office (NCPO) to strictly and effectively monitor the implementation of trimobile fare as embodied in Ordinance No. 93-049 amended by Ordinance No. 2008-055.
