**A RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION AND GRATITUDE FOR NAGA CITY SCHOOL COMMUNITIES FOR THEIR RESPONSE TO THE CALL FOR DONATIONS TO PARTICULAR NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN IN EVACUATION CENTERS DUE TO THE THREAT OF MAYON VOLCANO ERUPTION:-**

**WHEREAS**, the frightening threat of Mayon Volcano eruption forced families within declared danger zones to seek temporary refuge in safer evacuation centers, and at one time the number of refugees swelled to over fifty-eight thousand, mostly children;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod dispatched a team from the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) precisely to identify the needed assistance to those families; and, in fact, among those identified needs and recommended at the evacuation centers were sanitation and hygiene kits for children;

**WHEREAS**, while the Sangguniang Panlungsod appealed to various groups and institutions for the other needs, it invited school communities specifically for the sanitation and hygiene needs particularly of the young in the evacuation centers;

**WHEREAS**, the second wave of boxes of these donations were delivered to City Hall or picked up by personnel of the Naga City School Board;

**WHEREAS**, such gesture of generosity for those in need and of solidarity with those in peril manifested by school communities—pupils and students and their families, teachers and staff members, deserves sincere appreciation and gratefulness;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on joint and collective motion of the Members of the 11<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga;
