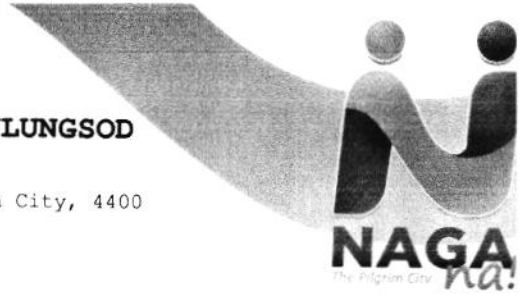

**RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), BEING THE AGENCY CHARGED WITH THE RE-CONDUCT OF THE PCL NATIONAL/ISLAND ELECTIONS, TO RE-OPEN THE FILING OF THE CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY THEREFOR:-**

On Joint and Collective Motion

**WHEREAS**, the 11<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Philippine Councilors League (PCL) was held on February 26-28, 2020 at the SMX Convention Center, Pasay City, for the election of the PCL National/Island Officers but the interim PCL National Officers declared a failure of elections due to "technical glitches" of the computer system which was supposed to be used in the automated elections;

**WHEREAS**, the failed PCL elections resulted in the more than Two Hundred Million Pesos (P200,000,000.00++) of government money going down the drain;

**WHEREAS**, in the mind of thousands of PCL members, the failed PCL elections clearly showed an utter failure of leadership on the part of the PCL interim national officers as shown by the following:

1. The interim national officers failed to provide sufficient time for all parties to inspect the system so that if problems are noted there will be sufficient time to correct them prior to the scheduled voting.;
2. The interim national officers failed to provide a back up plan;
3. The election could have pushed through by way of manual elections had the interim national officers carried out the decision made by them at 3:30 p.m. of 27 February 2020 to resort to manual voting;

**WHEREAS**, due to such manifest failure of leadership, thousands of councilors had called for the resignation of the interim national officers and declared as vacant the seats which are up for election;

**WHEREAS**, in the re-conduct of the PCL National/Island Elections, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) as the agency which has supervision over local government leagues shall be taking the lead;

**WHEREAS**, in the re-conduct of the PCL National/Island Elections, the DILG should open the filing of certificates of candidacy again, otherwise, the interim national officers who were unopposed in the failed election will be rewarded with a sure win instead of being held accountable for their failed leadership;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on joint and collective motion of the 13<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, TO EARNESTLY REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), BEING THE AGENCY CHARGED WITH THE RE-CONDUCT OF THE PCL NATIONAL/ISLAND ELECTIONS, TO RE-OPEN THE FILING OF THE CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY THEREFOR:-
