
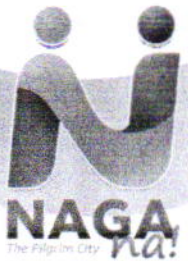

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF NAGA UNDER STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE DEVASTATION WROUGHT BY SUPER TYPHOON "ROLLY" ON NOVEMBER 1, 2020:-**

On joint and collective motion

**WHEREAS**, on November 1, 2020, the City of Naga was one of the areas in the country that was ravaged by Super Typhoon "Rolly", which is reported as the strongest storm in the world so far this year, amidst the COVID-19 pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, the city was placed under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) Number 5, with maximum sustained winds of 225 kilometers per hour near the center and gustiness of up to 310 kilometers per hour;

**WHEREAS**, with its catastrophic winds and torrential rains, Super Typhoon "Rolly" brought flooding and wrought enormous damage to public utilities, trees, houses, and infrastructure in the city;

**WHEREAS**, the world's strongest storm so far this year came while the city is still recovering from Typhoon Quinta which battered the city nearly a week before and while Naga is still working to combat the spread of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19);

**WHEREAS**, due to the extent of the damage, particularly to the underprivileged, it is imperative that the City of Naga be declared under State of Calamity in order for the city government to immediately and adequately respond to the needs of the typhoon victims;

**WHEREAS**, finding the same to be in order and necessary;
