MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into by and between:

LABTOX ANALYTICAL LABORATORY INC. existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines with principal address at **4/F Garpas Tower, 31 V. Luna Road cor Mabilis St., Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City** represented herein by its Manager Maricar C. Carasi now herein referred to as the First Party;

And

NAGA CITY HOSPITAL DRUG TESTING CENTER (name of lab.), existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines with office address at PENAFRANCIA AVENUE, NAGA CITY (address) represented herein by HON. NELSON S. LEGACION (owner) now hereinafter referred to as the Second Party:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The First Party is a duly DOH-accredited Confirmatory Drug Testing Laboratory.

WHEREAS, The Second Party is a duly DOH-accredited Screening Drug Testing Laboratory desires to affiliate with the First Party and as such the First Party shall conduct the confirmatory tests of the Second party.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties in consideration of the undertaking and commitments of each Party to the other Party set forth herein, hereby agree as follows:

1. The location of the Second Party's drug testing laboratory shall be at PENAFRANCIA AVENUE, NAGA CITY (address)
2. The initial term of this agreement shall be for a period beginning on the day this agreement is signed and ending two (2) years later unless the agreement is terminated sooner.
 - 2.1 Notwithstanding the foregoing, the First Party shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate this agreement if Second Party fails to follow the agreement as stated, does not operate according to the standard laboratory operation manual set by the First Party and does not follow the rules and regulations of the DOH/HFSRB.
3. The Second Party shall submit to the First Party for confirmatory test all specimens they screened which yielded positive results.
4. The Second Party agrees to operate the drug screening laboratory in accordance with such uniform methods, standards and specifications of the First Party in order to insure the highest degree of quality, service and uniformity


5. The Second Party agrees to operate the drug testing center in compliance with applicable laws and government regulations, the rules and regulations of the Dangerous Drugs Board, DOH/BFHS in accordance with the standards established by the First Party. The Second Party will obtain at his own expense and keep in force, any permits, licenses or other consents required for leasing, construction or operation, including without limitation sales and income tax, health and sanitation permits, business permits, DTI Business name registration, license to operate or accreditation from DOH/HFSRB.
6. Both Parties shall comply with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (Republic Act 10173) and its implementing rules and regulations issued by National Privacy Commission.


