ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2017-005

CONSTITUTING A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE OF THE CITY DANGEROUS DRUG PROGRAM PRIOR TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2017-0018 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH Entitled "Guidelines for Community-based Treatment and Support Services for Persons Who Use Drugs in Primary Health Care Settings" DEFINING ITS PURPOSE, COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to existing laws and/or local ordinances, the City Government of Naga, spearheaded by the Naga City Dangerous Drugs Board (NCDDDB), has been implementing programs, projects, and activities against drug abuse;

WHEREAS, the TWG shall ensure that the goals and objectives of Government Drug Campaign such as the following are met;

1. At least 75% of Surrendering Drug Users (SDUs) assessed by each Core Team before year end;
2. At least 75% of Persons Who Use Drugs (PWUDs) enrolled or have undergone interventions before the end of 2017:

WHEREAS, the TWG shall study the Regional Consolidated Report of the status and accomplishment of the screening and assessment of drug users conducted by the Core Team of the respective municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, do hereby order the following:

1. The Technical Working Group to ensure the compliance of the City to the Government Drug Campaign is hereby created with the following composition:

Chairman: Renne F. Gumba (PSO/JMR Center for Good Governance))

Members: Dr. Vito C. Borja II (CHO)


Jose B. Importante (NCDDDB)

2. The TWG will convene on Monday November 6, 2017 12:00nn at the MetroPeso White Room. However, the TWG shall meet only once every quarter to perform the following functions and responsibilities:
 - a. Consolidate all concerns and issues related to the city's compliance guided by the existing DOH Administrative Order No. 2017-0018 and DILG MC 2017-127;
 - b. Update and recommend to the City Mayor appropriate disposition of concerns and issues, consistent with the city's short and long-term development plans.


This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.

Let copies of this order be furnished all concerned for their appropriate action.
