



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2019-064

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CREATING THE MATERNAL NEWBORN CHILD HEALTH AND NUTRITION TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the Department of Health, through Administrative Order No. 2008-0029, recommends the implementation of the Maternal Newborn Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) Strategy, and states that the risk of mistimed, unplanned, unwanted, and unsupported pregnancy, which leads to maternal, infant, and neonatal deaths, can be prevented if appropriate health interventions are introduced, such as family planning interventions;

WHEREAS, the City of Naga believes that the goal of rapidly reducing maternal and neonatal mortality shall be achieved through effective population-wide provision and use of integrated MNCHN services for women, mothers, and children covering the spectrum of (1) known appropriate clinic case management services in preventing direct causes of maternal and neonatal deaths; and (2) known cost-effective public health measures capable of reducing exposure to and severity of risks for maternal and neonatal deaths, that are within the capacity of the health system to routinely provide;

WHEREAS, the City of Naga supports the implementation of MNCHN Strategy;

NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following

SECTION 1. MATERNAL NEWBORN CHILD HEALTH AND NUTRITION TASK FORCE. The MNCHN Task Force shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The Task Force shall be the overall coordinating and implementing body for the implementation of the MNCHN Strategy and Plan in the City of Naga.

In addition, the Task Force shall perform and exercise the following duties and functions:

- (a) Formulate a comprehensive MNCHN Plan and oversee its implementation;
- (b) Undertake program monitoring and evaluation and provide a program feedback mechanism;
- (c) In close coordination with barangay governments and other agencies concerned, conduct and update date of Women of Reproductive Age (WRA) and FP users;


- (d) Provide support in strengthening capacities for FP/MNCHN service provision through the conduct of training courses and other capacity-building activities;
- (e) Provide support in the conduct of activities related to FP/MNCHN education and counselling of clients about FP and safe motherhood; and
- (f) Establish and maintain linkages with local, national, and international population-serving organizations or institutions.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
