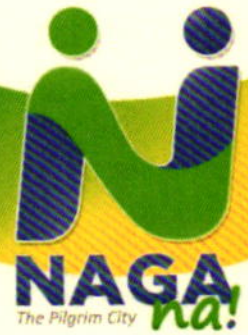






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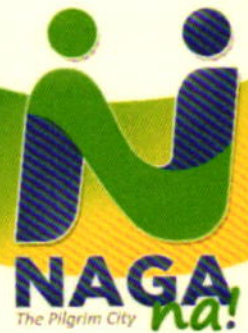

<b>CATEGORY I</b>		
1. Public and private hospitals		100%
2. Health, emergency, and frontline services, including those provided by dialysis centers, chemotherapy centers, HMOs, health insurance providers, disaster risk reduction management officers, and public safety officers and the like		100%
3. Manufacturers of medicines and vitamins, medical supplies, devices, and equipment, including suppliers of input, packaging, and distribution		100%
4. Industries involved in agriculture (crops, fruits, vegetables, livestock, and poultry), forestry, fishery, and such other components of the food value chain and their workers, including farmers and fisher folks		100%
5. Logistics service providers (delivery and courier services; cargo handling; warehousing; trucking; freight forwarding; shipping, port, and terminal operators)		100%
6. Essential and priority construction projects, whether public or private, and small-scale construction projects such as those for housing or residential, in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)		100%
7. Manufacturing related to food and other essential goods such as but not limited to soap and detergents, diapers, personal hygiene products, toilet paper and wet wipes, and disinfectants		100%
8. Companies that manufacture, distribute and/or supply equipment or products		100%



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necessary to perform construction or maintenance works, such as cement and steel, or spare parts		
9. Essential retail trade and service establishments such as public markets, supermarkets, grocery stores, convenience stores, pharmacies or drug stores, hardware, office supplies, bicycle shops, laundry shops, and water-refilling stations		100%
10. Food preparation establishments such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries		
a. Takeout and delivery		100%
b. Outdoor dine-in services (al fresco)	50%	60%
c. Indoor dine-in services	20%	30%
11. Public and private financial service providers involved in the distribution of government grants and amelioration subsidies		100%
12. Business process outsourcing establishments (BPOs), and export-oriented businesses, including mining and quarrying activities		100%
13. Public transport providers and operators subject to the Department of Transportation (DOTr) guidelines		100%
14. Media establishments and their total permanent staff complement, inclusive of reporters and other field employees		100%
15. Dental, rehabilitation, optometry, and other medical clinics for the treatment of illness or injuries. - <i>Provided, that there is strict observance of infection prevention and control protocols. Provided, further, that the wearing of full Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs) by dentists and attendants shall be mandatory. Provided, finally, that home service therapy for Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) shall be allowed</i>		100%
