EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022-021
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**RECONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandates the creation of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) in every local government unit;

WHEREAS, Naga City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NCDRRMC) seeks to promote the involvement and participation of all sectors and stakeholders in the adoption of a holistic, comprehensive, integrated and proactive disaster risk management approach that is geared towards mitigating socio-economic and environmental impacts of disasters including climate change;

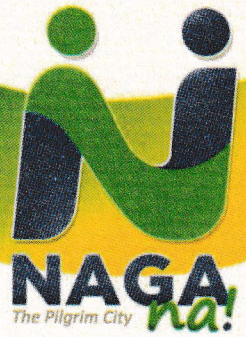
NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. NAGA CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT COUNCIL.** The Naga City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NCDRRMC) is hereby constituted, to be composed of the following:

The **twenty-seven Punong Barangays** may participate as observers during the meetings but they cannot vote or propose resolutions.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The Council shall have the following duties:

1. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plans (LDRRMPs) and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
2. Review the proposed Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) and recommend its approval to the Sanggunian;



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3. Recommend to the Sanggunian the release and utilization of the unexpended balance of the LDRRMF for new expenditures, as well as the inclusion in the Annual Investment Plan of new programs or projects to be undertaken;
4. Ensure the integration of Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation in local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
5. Recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and,
6. Recommend to the Local Chief Executive the suspension of classes at local levels even in the absence of a Typhoon Warning Signal.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The Naga City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (NCDRRMO) shall serve as Secretariat of the Council.


SECTION 4. MEETINGS AND QUORUMS. The meeting of the Council shall be held once every three (3) months on the dates and place determined by the body. The Local Chief Executive, as Chairperson, may call for a special meeting as he may deem necessary. The presence of one-third (1/3) of the members shall constitute a quorum to transact business at any meeting of the council.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
