RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS - CAMARINES SUR 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE TO FINANCE AND IMPLEMENT THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAN FELIPE-BALATAS-MAHARLIKA (CONCEPCION GRANDE) BYPASS ROAD IN NAGA CITY:-

On joint and collective motion

WHEREAS, the City Government of Naga under its current administration has envisioned to make Naga a city where progress is all inclusive and everyone is happy and proud of their community and their government;

WHEREAS, essential to this vision is the availability of adequate standard infrastructure facilities necessary to facilitate delivery of and enjoyment by the people of government services;

WHEREAS, the current city administration, since the beginning of its term in 2019, has placed premium in promoting equitable socio-economic development by establishing new schools, instituting new health care centers and a new hospital, opening new roads and setting up a number of other initiatives towards the achievement of the Nagueños' collective dream for Naga and for their families;

WHEREAS, due to the present public health crisis, however, our initiatives have been hampered and many proposed projects have been placed on hold as we encounter shortage of funds and redirection of our resources to combat the pandemic;

WHEREAS, with a decline in COVID-19 cases and as the whole country slowly roll back to normalcy, the City Government of Naga is hopeful that its development projects can now be implemented with the help of the National Government and other agencies and partners;

WHEREAS, partnership is crucial in realizing the collective aspiration of Nagueños, especially so that the city continues to struggle financially as tax collections declined as a consequence of the reduction of production and closure of local businesses during the lockdowns and other restrictions that were implemented to contain the pandemic;
