EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022 - 005

UPDATING THE NAGA CITY LAND TRAVEL GUIDELINES

Whereas, the Inter-agency Task Force on Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) has begun deescalating alert level statuses of key cities in the country in particular those in the National Capital Region;

Whereas, Naga City, although still under Alert Level 3, has shown continuous improvement in COVID19 numbers, with low critical care utilization rate at twenty-two (22%) percent;

Now therefore, given the above information, **I, Nelson S. Legacion**, Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following guidelines on the entry of travelers or returning residents to Naga City:

Section 1. Regardless of the place of origin in the Philippines, fully vaccinated and asymptomatic travelers shall be granted entry to Naga City without any quarantine and/or COVID19 testing requirement. However, travelers must present their respective vaccination and identification cards to Barangay Health Emergency Response Task Force of the Barangay where they will be staying for information and monitoring.

Section 2. Partially vaccinated or unvaccinated as well as symptomatic travelers regardless of vaccination status are required to present negative antigen or RT-PCR test result taken within 48 hours before departure from place of origin and valid identification card to Barangay Health Emergency Response Task Force of the Barangay where they will be staying for information and monitoring.

Section 3. The above documentary requirements shall not apply to persons involved in emergencies and those accessing medical care.

Section 4. The Bicol Central Station Management is directed to make necessary coordination with other agencies such as PITX, LTFRB and LTO relative to these new guidelines. The City Events, Protocol and Public Information Office shall cause the widest dissemination of this Order.

Section 5. Should any provision of this Order or any part thereof be declared invalid, the other provisions, insofar as they are separable from the invalid ones, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Executive Order takes effect on 12:01 am of February 5, 2022 and repeals Rule II of Executive Order No. 2022-001.

Naga City Land Travel Entry Protocols

Effective February 5, 2022

The requirements shall be presented to the Barangay Health Emergency Response Task Force of the Barangay where the traveler will be staying.

Note: Travelers disembarking at Naga Airport being situated in Pili, Camarines Sur shall be governed by the protocols issued by the Province of Camarines Sur
