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## AMENDING RULE I OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022-001 BY ALLOWING FULLY VACCINATED 12 TO 17 YEARS OLD TO ENTER COMMERCIAL, PRIVATE AND PUBLIC ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, Naga City's COVID19 numbers are improving everyday and a high percentage of COVID19 patients are either asymptomatic or are experiencing very mild symptoms, which could be managed already at home;

WHEREAS, under IATF regulations, provided that there is a manageable and improving COVID19 situation in the locality, a Local Chief Executive is granted the discretion to allow fully vaccinated 12 to 17 years old children to go out of their homes and visit commercial, private and public establishments;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION**, Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby amend Rule I of Executive Order No. 2022-001, to now to read as follows:

#### RULE I

# ENTRY TO ESTABLISHMENTS

1. An individual must be able to present the following documents to the guardon-duty or designated inspection personnel **at the main entrance of the building or facility** to be allowed entry to any enclosed commercial, private, and public establishments as well as places of worship:

	12 to 17 years old	18 years old and over
Vaccination Card	Indicating full vaccination or two doses of either Moderna or Pfizer vaccines	Indicating partial, full, or booster vaccination
Identification Card	Required to both age groups	
E-Salvar QR Code or Health Declaration and contact tracing form	Required to both age groups	

- 2. For unvaccinated workers, the following may be used in lieu of the vaccination card:
  - a. negative antigen or RT-PCR test at least taken 48 hours before entry to establishments



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- b. Certificate of Vaccination Exemption issued by their respective Municipal or City Health Officers
- 3. The above age-based restriction and documentary requirements shall not apply to persons involved in emergencies and those accessing medical care.
- 4. Failure of heads of establishments and places of worship to impose this rule and other succeeding applicable rules shall be prosecuted for noncooperation of the person or entities punishable under Section 9 par. (d) or (e) of Republic Act No. 11332, otherwise known as the Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

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## RULE X OTHER PROVISIONS

- 1. This Executive Order may be amended from time to time, as the need arises, in view of the exigencies of the COVID-19 situation.
- 2. Should any provision of this Order or any part thereof be declared invalid, the other provisions, insofar as they are separable from the invalid ones, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. All executive issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 4. This Executive Order shall take effect on February 12, 2022
