## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-637

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM), THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS (COMELEC), AND THE NATIONAL YOUTH COMMISSION (NYC) TO EXPEDITE THE NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 11768 WHICH AMENDS REPUBLIC ACT 10742, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REFORMS ACT OF 2015":-

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution states that the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social wellbeing. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, RA 10742, otherwise known as the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015", introduced some significant changes to the SK and enabled the council to play a bigger and more efficient role in their respective constituencies;

WHEREAS, RA 11768, which was signed by President Duterte on May 18, 2022, introduces reforms to the SK through the grant of honoraria and other benefits such as social welfare contributions and hazard pay for SK leaders. Included in the law, as well, is the provision that exempts SK members from partaking in the National Service Training Program and excuses them from regular classes while attending regular or special meetings;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of RA 11768 states that SK members, including the Sangguniang Kabataan treasurer and secretary, shall receive a monthly honorarium, chargeable against the Sangguniang Kabataan funds, in addition to any other compensation provided by this Act and shall be granted at the end of every regular monthly SK meeting;



WHEREAS, Monthly compensation shall not exceed the monthly compensation received by the SK Chairperson, and that not more than 25% of the SK Funds shall be allocated for Personnel Services;

WHEREAS, Section 16 also states that local government units may provide additional honorarium as well as social welfare contributions and hazard pay to the Sangguniang Kabataan chairperson and the elected and appointed members through their own local ordinances;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2019-021 established within the City of Naga a reform that aims to strengthen and empower the

SK through the grant of honoraria to elected SK Officials-including SK Kagawads, SK Secretaries, and SK Treasurers-prior to the National Legislature creating RA 11768;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of RA 11768 states that the Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation, thus, allowing for the execution of said law;

WHEREAS, the immediate implementation of RA 11768 in the City of Naga would be a charitable favor to the youth sector of our city as well as the elected SK Officials as well as further impress upon our residents that the city puts high value towards our youth.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Mary Kyle Francine B. Tripulca duly seconded by Hon. Jessie R. Albeus, Hon. Joselito S.A. del Rosario and Hon. Ghiel G. Rosales;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to urge the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Commission on Elections (COMELEC), and the National Youth Commission (NYC) to expedite the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 11768 which amends Republic Act 10742, otherwise known as the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reforms Act of 2015".

LET COPIES of this resolution be furnished to His Honor, the City Mayor, for his concurrence, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Commission on Elections (COMELEC), and the National Youth Commission (NYC) for their respective information and appropriate action.
