



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2022-031

ACTIVATING THE NAGA CITY PENAFRANCIA JOINT OPERATIONS CENTER, CONSTITUTING THE JOINT INFORMATION CENTER AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND COMPOSITION

WHEREAS, devotees, pilgrims, members of the clergy, vicars, government officials, VIPs, official guests and visitors, numbering to millions, will converge in the City of Naga for the month-long celebration in line with the Peñafrancia Festivities;

WHEREAS, Presidential Executive Order No. 33, Series of 2010, has declared Naga City as a Pilgrimage Capital of the country and has instructed that "the programs and activities instituted during the Peñafrancia Festival must be conducted in an atmosphere of peace and order that must be assisted and maintained by the government, and that the solemnity and sensitivity of the nature and character of the festivities must be preserved";

WHEREAS, due to the risk involved in the influx of visitors and pilgrims, there is a need for the City of Naga to activate the Peñafrancia Joint Operations Center tasked to develop an effective and efficient command, control, coordination, collaboration and communication system of the Festivity;

WHEREAS, the Joint Operation Center will provide a centralized focus of authority and information, will allow for face-to-face coordination among personnel, will set priorities for use of resources and will evaluate the need to request mutual aid;

WHEREAS, in view of the need of having a unified and coordinated festivity and critical emergency information, crisis communications, and public affairs functions, a Joint Information Center shall be also be established as a component of the Joint Operations Center;


NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. THE JOINT OPERATIONS CENTER. The Joint Operations Center is hereby activated to be composed of the following:












SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The various components of the Joint Operations Center shall have the following functions:

- **a. JOINT OPERATIONS CENTER CHIEFS -** provide the over-all guidance in the conduct of activities and functions of the Joint Operations Center;
- b. JOINT OPERATIONS ADVISORY COMMITTEE The Joint Operations Advisory Committee shall be Chaired by the Executive Director of the Public Safety Office and Chief Resilience Officer. It shall ensure that the plans formulated by the Inter-Agency Joint Task Group are properly reviewed and are in line with the "solemnity and sensitivity of the nature and character of the festivity". It shall also ensure that the security plans and contingency plans, including emergency preparedness and response plans, formulated by the Inter-Agency Joint Task Group are in harmony with the long-held traditions essential to the feast, which include but are not limited to the Traslacion, the Fluvial and Dawn Processions and other Diocesan, religious, cultural and historical remembrance activities, including social events, trade fairs, motorcades and parades.



- Pool vital resources and supervise security, public safety, health emergency and sanitation, emergency response and disaster preparedness operations;
- Carry out the principles of emergency preparedness and emergency management or disaster management function at a strategic level in an emergency situation;
- Establish a command, control, coordination and collaboration, and communication system for the over-all disaster emergency response;
- Implement plans and programs, ensure the security and public safety, peace and order, address threats to internal security and safety, ensure means for fire suppression, respond to all kinds of emergencies and implement disaster preparedness mechanisms for natural, manmade, human induced hazards, and provide HAZMAT response and bio hazards threats and pandemic response;
- Create committees as it may deem necessary to carry out the objectives of this Executive Order.







SECTION 3. THE JOINT INFORMATION CENTER. Realizing the need for coordinated, factual and timely critical emergency information, crisis communications and public information before, during and after the staging of the Peñafrancia Festival, a Joint Information Center composed of the following is hereby constituted:


- City Events, Protocol and Public Information Officer
- Philippine Information Agency Camarines Sur Provincial Officer
- Caceres Commission on Communication Director
- Kapisanan ng mga Brodkaster ng PIlipinas- Camarines Sur Chapter Chairman
- Naga City Hall Press Corps President
- 9th Infantry Division Philippine Army Spokesperson
- Naga City Police Office Spokesperson
- Philippine National Police Regional Office Spokesperson
- Kabalikat Civicom RV Chairman
- Philippine News Agency

SECTION 4. NATURE AND FUNCTION OF THE JIC. The Joint Information Center is a vital component of the Joint Operations Center. It shall have the following tasks and functions:

- Take charge of developing and delivering coordinated interagency messages;
- Develop, recommend and execute public information plans and strategies on behalf of the Joint Operations Center;
- Advise the Joint Operations Center through the chiefs and designated Incident Commanders concerning public affairs issues;
- Identify and address misinformation and inaccurate information;
- Identify the key information that needs to be communicated to the public;
- Craft clear and easily understandable messages that convey key information;
- Prioritize messages to ensure timely delivery of information without overwhelming the audience;
- Verify accuracy of information through appropriate channels, including the Incident Command and relevant agencies and program areas; and
- Disseminate messages using the most effective means available.









SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
