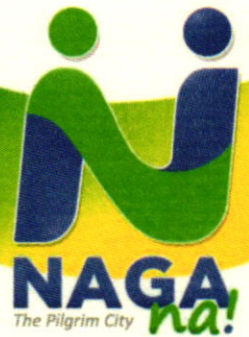

- Head, Overseas Workers Welfare Administration – Naga City


SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The LCAT-VAWC shall:


- a) Institute policies and programs to protect women and children who are victims of trafficking-in-persons (TIP) and violence against women and their children (VAWC);
- b) Create and establish systems on surveillance, investigation, and rescue to ensure effective and efficient coordination among relevant agencies and sectors;
- c) Undertake information, education, and advocacy campaign against TIP and VAWC;
- d) Monitor and oversee the strict implementation of RA 9208, RA 9262, and other related laws for the protection of women and children, and of the IACAT and IACVAWC national plans of action.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
