The ATENEO DE NAGA UNIVERSITY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, a private educational institution herein represented by FR. STEPHEN T. ABUAN, SJ, Senior High School Principal, Ateneo de Naga University and duly represented by Ms Rachele D. Silerio, SHS DRR Coordinator;

The UNIVERSITY OF NUEVA CACERES, a private educational institution herein represented by DR. FAY LEA PATRIA M. LAURAYA, President and duly represented by Ms. Gloria Labuanan, NSTP Coordinator, University of Nueva Caceres, Naga City;

WHEREAS, in line with this, the City Government, in close coordination with different national line agencies and private institutions, is undertaking programs and projects to increase the level of preparedness and resiliency of its institutions and citizenry. One of the strategies of these programs is the undertaking of disaster preparedness training for schools, business, establishments, and communities.

Whereas, the broadest reach and most efficient approach to such disaster preparedness can be undertaken through community-based trainings. At the community level, the most expansive coverage and effectiveness could be attained by requiring each family to complete such trainings.

Whereas, using such strategy, each family becomes capacitated and prepared to deal with emergency incidents and calamities, thus making the communities, and the city as a whole, equally ready to cope with natural and man-made disasters and emergencies.




Whereas, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga has enacted Ordinance No. 2017-007 entitled AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING A COMMUNITY-LEVEL DISASTER PREPAREDNESS TRAINING PROGRAM FOCUSING ON COMMUNITY FIRST RESPONDERS AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING FOR REPRESENTATIVES OF FAMILIES, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

Whereas, the City Government of Naga is seeking for the full support and cooperation of the different stakeholders, including private partners and non-government organizations to support this program;

Whereas, the City Government of Naga through the Naga City Community First Responders Program Management Office (NCCFRPMO) has already conducted and is continuously conducting trainings in line with this ordinance with the different schools and barangays as well as other agencies as participants and or support groups for the achievement of the purposes set thereunto in the Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the CITY and its partner organizations, in order to fully maximize the full potentials of the Ordinance, hereto acquiesce, agree, consent or accept the following tasks, duties or functions, to wit:

- 1) The CITY will:
 - A) Ensure sustainability of the Program through the Naga City Community First Responders Management Office (NCCFRMO) created under the Ordinance;
 - B) Provide the pool of volunteers to conduct training for basic life support and basic first aid under the close supervision of certified trainer/instructors;
- 2) The DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize students and personnel for the conduct of trainings on schedules mutually agreed upon by the parties;
 - b) Support the conduct of skills Olympics intended to test the participants' learning competencies after such trainings, on schedules mutually agreed upon by parties.
- 4) The ATENEO DE NAGA UNIVERSITY will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize its teaching and non-teaching personnel during the conduct of trainings for the students;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.
- 5) The UNIVERSITY OF NUEVA CACERES will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize its teaching and non-teaching personnel during the conduct of trainings for the students;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.
- 6) The UNIVERSIDAD DE STA ISABEL DE NAGA, INC. will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize its teaching and non-teaching personnel during the conduct of trainings for the students;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.
- 7) The PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize its personnel during the conduct of trainings;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.



- 8) The BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION will endeavor to
 - a) Mobilize its personnel during the conduct of trainings;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.

- 7) The LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY will endeavor to:
 - a) Ensure that barangay participants are provided with the necessary support to meet the requirements of the Program;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.

- 8) The SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN FEDERATION will endeavor to:
 - a) Ensure that barangay participants are provided with the necessary support to meet the requirements of the Program;
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.

- 9) The CITY HALL PRESS CORPS will endeavor to:
 - a) Provide updates to the general public, whether in print or TV/radio broadcast/webcast; and
 - b) Develop, in coordination with the LGU and other partners, mechanisms to further enhance the Program's implementation.


