



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2023-012

CONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY POWER COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2014-044 of the City Government of Naga has institutionalized the creation of a Naga City Power Commission;

WHEREAS, over the years, the implementation of the provisions of the aforesaid ordinance is wanting;

WHEREAS, given the formidable challenges facing the energy sector in Naga City, it is imperative that the ordinance be considered seriously and be implemented fully;


NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Naga City Power Commission shall be composed of the following: -

- Chairperson, SP Committee on Environment and Energy
- Chairperson, SP Committee on Public Utilities
- Chairperson, SP Committee on Consumers Protection
- Chairman, SP Committee on People empowerment and Participation
- Department Head, City Planning and Development Office
- Chief of Office, City Environment and Natural Resources Office
- Executive Director, Jesse M. Robredo Center for Good Governance
- Executive Director, Metro Naga Development Council
- Manager, Camarines Sur II Electric Cooperative (CASURECO II)
- CASURECO II BOD Member representing Naga North
- CASURECO II BOD Member representing Naga South
- Chairperson, Naga City People's Council
- President, Metro Naga Chamber of Commerce and Industry
- Representative, Institute of Integrated Electrical Engineers of the Philippines
- Representative, CASURECO II Consumers Group
- Representative, Metro Naga Water District
- Representative, Academe –
- Representative, Naga City Liga ng mga Barangay
- Head, CNPC-TWG









The members shall elect from among themselves a Chairperson who shall come from the private sector.

The Head of the City Planning and Development Office shall serve as the Vice-Chairperson.

SECTION 2. NATURE AND FUNCTIONS. The Naga City Power Commission shall serve as the multi-sectoral consultative policy and planning body that shall provide the City of Naga with comprehensive and effective strategies for the provision of electric energy required to sustain the City's economic growth and development.

It shall ensure that the provisions and intentions of Ordinance No. 2014-044 are given flesh and are fully implemented.

In the performance of its functions, the Commission may request the assistance of any other offices of the City Government and seek out wider stakeholders' participation.

SECTION 3. INTERNAL RULES OF PROCEDURE. The Naga City Power Commission may adopt its own internal rules of procedure as it may deem necessary for the orderly conduct of its operations and the effective performance of its functions.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT. The City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall serve as the Secretariat of the Commission. It shall ensure timely, effective and efficient delivery of manpower and administrative assistance to the Commission.


SECTION 5. TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. The Naga City Power Commission shall be provided with technical assistance by a Technical Working Group (CNPC-TWG) which is hereby constituted and is composed of the following:

- a. Electrical Engineering Section Chief, City Engineer's Office;
- b. Chief, Building Maintenance Office
- c. Representative, , Camarines Sur Electric Cooperative (CASURECO) II
- d. Representative from the private sector with technical knowledge on energy research, development, production and distribution.

Upon recommendation of the CNPC-TWG, the Commission may invite other individuals or entities to render technical assistance and form part of the group.









The City Mayor shall designate the head of the TWG who shall sit as an exofficio member of the Power Commission.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
