ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO INVESTIGATE THE DEATH OF ROSELLE BANDOJO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51 (b) of Republic Act No. 6975, the City Mayor has operational supervision over the units of the Philippine National Police within the territorial jurisdiction of his local government unit;

WHEREAS, the term "operational supervision and control," as outlined in the aforementioned section, encompasses the authority to direct, oversee, superintend, and inspect police units and forces, as well as includes the power to employ and deploy PNP units or elements for the purpose of maintaining public safety, upholding peace and order, and apprehending criminal offenders;

WHEREAS, the local government bears the responsibility of safeguarding the safety and welfare of its citizens;

WHEREAS, the untimely and tragic death of Roselle Bandojo, a senior high school student, in a vacant lot in Barangay Liboton demands a thorough and expeditious investigation;

WHEREAS, it is imperative to bring the perpetrators of this heinous crime to justice and provide a sense of closure to the grieving family;

WHEREAS, establishing a task group composed of select members of National Bureau of Investigation, Naga City Police Office and the City Government of Naga will enable the convergence of expertise and specialized skills crucial for resolving the intricacies of the case;

WHEREAS, a multidisciplinary approach ensures a comprehensive examination of various dimensions, including legal, technical, medical, and social aspects;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF A COMPOSITE TASK GROUP. A Composite Task Group is hereby established to investigate the death of Roselle Bandojo, with the following composition:

SECTION 2. MANDATES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Task Group is tasked to conduct a thorough and comprehensive investigation into the circumstances surrounding the untimely death of Roselle Bandojo, including but not limited to the following:

- a. Gathering and analyzing evidence related to the case;
- b. Identifying and apprehending the individuals responsible for the crime;
- c. Interviewing witnesses and persons of interest;
- d. Collaborating with other law enforcement agencies, as necessary;
- e. Providing periodic updates to the public and the family of the victim; and
- f. Recommending measures to prevent the happening of similar incidents in the future.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY. The Task Group is authorized to call upon personnel from other relevant agencies, as needed, to carry out its tasks effectively. The Task Group is also granted access to facilities, equipment, and resources required for the swift resolution of the case.

SECTION 4. FUNDING. The amount necessary for the conduct of investigations by the Task Group shall be charged from the Intelligence and Confidential Fund of the City Government of Naga.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its issuance and shall remain in force until the resolution of the case.
