AN ORDER ASSIGNING THE MANAGEMENT OF THE FIREARMS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF NAGA TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE AND DESIGNATING MR. RENNE F. GUMBA AS THE AUTHORIZED BONDED FIREARM CUSTODIAN THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City Government of Naga (CGN) procured various types of firearms for its security purposes and currently under the custody of the General Services Department;

WHEREAS, the security of public facilities owned and maintained by the CGN as well as providing civil security assistance are within the mandate of the Public Safety Office (PSO);

WHEREAS, the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations 2018 of RA No. 10591, otherwise known as "An Act Providing for a Comprehensive law on Firearms and Ammunition and Providing Penalties for Violations thereof," has provided for instructional guide for firearms registration and renewal process;

WHEREAS, it is imperative to ensure the proper management through the timeliness of the registration of the said firearms and promptly comply with national policies on the ownership of the said firearms.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following: SECTION 1. MANAGEMENT. The management of the firearms owned and maintained by the CGN is hereby assigned to the PSO.


**SECTION 2. DESIGNATION.** Mr. Renne F. Gumba, the PSO Head, is hereby designated as the authorized bonded firearm custodian, who shall meet the standard requirements and qualifications mentioned in the Revised 2018 IRR of RA No. 10591. As such, he is hereby authorized to sign, any and all documents for and in behalf of the CGN relative to firearms registration and compliance with national policies.

**SECTION 3. FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**: The PSO and its Head shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

1. Perform all acts of management to ensure the proper handling and storage of the firearms;









- 2. Promptly comply with national policies and directives relative to the registration, possession and maintenance of the firearms;
- 3. Ensure compliance to the requirements and qualifications of the CGN employees who are allowed to possess firearms owned by the CGN and registered under its name; and
- 4. Perform such other incidental and necessary functions as directed by law, order and ordinance.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and be valid until sooner revoked or amended.
