



CONSTITUTING THE NAGA CITY COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM COORDINATING BOARD

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11315, otherwise known as Community-Based Monitoring System Act (CBMS Act), was enacted on 17 April 2019;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid law has institutionalized the CBMS, which is an organized technology-based system of collecting, processing, and validating necessary disaggregated data that may be used for planning, program implementation, and impact monitoring at the local level while empowering communities to participate in the process;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the abovementioned Republic Act commands a city to be the primary data-collecting authority within its locality;


WHEREAS, Section 6 of RA 11315 states that the Philippine Statistics Authority shall serve as the lead agency in the implementation of the CBMS, and shall monitor the data collection by cities and municipalities to ensure adherence to official concepts, definitions, and standards of poverty statistics;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the abovementioned law provides for the creation of the CBMS Council composed of the PSA, Department of the Interior and Local Government and Department of Information and Communications Technology for purposes of achieving secure and efficient data sharing arrangements between and among concerned cities and municipalities and national government agencies to be used for their particular social protection and welfare programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the CBMS Council approves Resolution No. 06, Series of 2021 on the establishment of the Provincial and City/Municipal Coordinating Board that will be responsible in overseeing the CBMS operations in their respective locality, in ensuring that logistic and other requirements are in place prior and during the CBMS operations, and in resolving issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMS in their jurisdiction;









WHEREAS, the CBMS Council approves Resolution No. 01, Series of 2022, amending the composition of the CBMS Coordinating Boards;

NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON S. LEGACION, City Mayor of Naga City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:




SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE NAGA CITY CBMS COORDINATING BOARD. The NCCCB shall perform the following functions:

- 1. Oversee the implementation of the CBMS operations in the city;
- 2. Resolve issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMS;
- 3. Facilitate the approval and timely release of funds, if any, and/or other requirements for the conduct of CBMS.
- 4. Issue communications, directives, instructions, and/or circulars to mobilize, and provide support/assistance to CBMS operations, which include, but not limited to, the following:
 - a. Coordination meetings and activities
 - b. Publicity and information campaign for the conduct of CBMS
 - c. Venue for and headquarters for the enumeration personnel and machine processing
 - d. Transportation facilities for the enumeration personnel, and the transport of CBMS forms, supplies, and materials
 - e. Communication and wireless Internet connection facility
 - f. Storage area for tablets, forms, and other materials
 - g. Health and legal services to CBMS personnel
 - h. Facilitation of enumeration in government-owned and private institutions, and other hard-to-reach areas.
- 5. Take up other matters as necessary for the successful conduct of the CBMS.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.
