**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF NAGA UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE MASSIVE INUNDATION BROUGHT BY TROPICAL STORM "KRISTINE" FROM OCTOBER 22, 2024 TO OCTOBER 23, 2024:-**

On joint and collective motion

**WHEREAS**, the Bicol Region including the City of Naga experienced heavy rainfall brought by Tropical Storm "Kristine" the entire day and night of October 22, 2024, until the early morning of October 23, 2024, while the whole city was under Storm Signal No. 2 declared by PAGASA, the State weather bureau;

**WHEREAS**, the torrential rains that hit the city brought volumes of water that have not been seen in Naga for decades that cannot be contained by the existing flood control infrastructures and congested waterways resulting to severe and widespread flooding, particularly in low-lying areas of the city;

**WHEREAS**, this natural occurrence affected thousands of families and individuals endangering their lives and properties, forcing many to leave their houses and properties with the City Mayor ordering the forced evacuation of those in high-risk areas, despite which, as of 1:30 PM today, claimed thirteen (13) lives and two (2) still missing persons of city residents;

**WHEREAS**, due to the extent of damage brought by the inundation, particularly to the underprivileged, it is imperative that the City of Naga be declared under the State of Calamity for the City Government to immediately and adequately respond to the needs of the flood victims;

**WHEREAS**, finding such declaration to be necessary and in order;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on joint and collective motion of the members of the 14<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of Naga;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to declare the City of Naga under the State of Calamity due to the massive inundation brought by Typhoon "Kristine" from October 22 2024 to October 23, 2024;




